Graiseley Primary School	Community School	0.4	262	1	65%	Good	14/02/14	<p><b>Minimal</b> – whilst the new free school is within close proximity to this primary school and its attainment results are significantly lower than the national and LA averages, this is mitigated by its 'good' Ofsted rating. The recent Ofsted report shows improvements in pupil achievement, teaching and leadership. The school also have very minimal surplus places at point of entry and is in an area of basic need.</p> <p>It is therefore not expected that The Royal School Wolverhampton will affect the long-term viability of this school.</p>
St Luke's Church of England Aided Primary School	Voluntary Aided School	0.4	420	0	78%	Good	12/11/14	<p><b>Minimal</b> – although this school is within close proximity to the free school, and attainment results are slightly lower than the national and LA average, this is mitigated by the 'good' Ofsted rating, no surplus places at point of entry. Recent Ofsted reports show that attainment in Maths and English is now at national average and improving. Teaching and leadership have also shown significant improvements. The school is a faith school (Church of England) and there is a basic need requirement in the area.</p> <p>It is therefore not expected that The Royal School Wolverhampton will affect the long-term viability of this school.</p>

Bantock Primary School	Community School	0.4	402	6	69%	Requires Improvement	20/06/14	<p><b>Minimal</b> – there is a minimal risk that the new free school will have an impact on this school. Although the school has a ‘requires improvement’ Ofsted rating a recent inspection shows improvements have been made. The school has only a small number of surplus places across a 2 form entry and is in an area of basic need.</p> <p>It is therefore not expected that The Royal School Wolverhampton will affect the long-term viability of this school.</p>
Woodfield Infant School	Community School	0.6	326	4	No KS2 data (highest age < 11)	Good	12/10/10	<p><b>Minimal</b> – the school has a ‘good’ Ofsted rating, and whilst there is no data available on pupil attainment rates, the surplus places at the point of entry are minimal.</p> <p>It is therefore not expected that The Royal School Wolverhampton will affect the long-term viability of this school.</p>
Woodfield Junior School	Community School	0.6	364	10	78%	Requires Improvement	18/06/14	<p><b>Minimal</b> – The school was rated as ‘requires improvement’ by Ofsted and has below average pupil attainment. However the Ofsted report does show that improvements have been made to pupils reading and there are some strength’s in the teaching of mathematics. Since the last inspection the governing body has taken action to improve the effectiveness of senior leadership. The school is now in a federation with Woodfield Infant School rated ‘good’ and support is being provided to further improve the school. The school has a small amount of surplus places available at point of entry across a 4 form entry.</p> <p>It is therefore not expected that The Royal School Wolverhampton will affect the long-term viability of this school.</p>

Nishkam Primary School Wolverhampton	Free Schools	0.7	116	8	No KS2 data	Requires Improvement	10/06/15	<p><b>Minimal –</b> the new school will have little impact on the viability of this free school. The school which opened in September 2013 was rated as 'requires improvement' by Ofsted in June 2105. However a recent inspection on May 2016 showed improvements had been made in pupil attainment in reading, writing and Mathematics. The school is also receiving support from other outstanding schools in the area to support their development and growth. The school has only a small amount of surplus places at point of entry and have recently grown to a 2 form entry. The school is a multi-faith, Sikh ethos, school for boys and girls aged 4-11, and are now part of the Nishkam Multi-Academy School Trust. Other schools within the MAT are outstanding.</p> <p>It is therefore not expected that The Royal School Wolverhampton will affect the long-term viability of this school.</p>
Merridale Primary School	Community School	0.7	210	1	83%	Good	28/02/14	<p><b>Minimal –</b> the new school will have little impact on the viability of this school. The school has a 'good' Ofsted rating, has above average pupil attainment and has no surplus places available at the point of entry.</p> <p>It is therefore not expected that The Royal School Wolverhampton will affect the long-term viability of this school.</p>

St Mary and John's Catholic Primary Academy	Academy Sponsor Led	0.8	210	0	71%	Good	30/01/15	<p><b>Minimal</b> – although the school has below average pupil attainment, this is mitigated by the 'good' Ofsted rating and no surplus places available at the point of entry. Recent Ofsted report shows that standards are rising across all areas and previous areas of weakness have been addressed. The school is also a faith school (Catholic) unlike the free school, so the pupil base may be quite different.</p> <p>It is therefore not expected that The Royal School Wolverhampton will affect the long-term viability of this school.</p>
