Once you have all the information you need, you can start planning how you will write your case study. Use the short guide below to make sure you include all the relevant information in the right order:

Paragraph 1 – Should briefly outline the most interesting elements of the case study, where they are from, what job they now have, what challenges they have overcome etc.

Paragraph 2 – Should go into detail about the jobseeker's history and background

Paragraph 3 – Should outline how the Work Club helped them to get a job

Paragraph 4 – Should provide an endorsement for the Work Club
