

LICENCE ANNEX B: Summary of all restrictions relating to licensed actions on Sites of Special Scientific Interest, Special Areas of Conservation, Special Protection Areas and RAMSAR Sites within the county of Hampshire

Protected sites that are within the assessment are not necessarily part of any active operations.

Active operations can and will only occur on protected sites where landowner permission has been granted.

Breamore Marsh SSSI		Exclude SSSI or avoid localities of vascular plants Limit location of traps to within sett footprint. Restrict vehicles to existing tracks.
Burton Common SSSI		Exclude SSSI or restrict vehicles to existing tracks. Avoid digging in areas of habitat suitable for sand lizard egg laying (open sand) between May and October and habitat suitable for hibernation between November and March. Avoid digging in area habitat suitable for smooth snake hibernation between November and March. Limit location of traps to existing sett footprint or areas of scrub
Highcliffe to Milford Cliffs SSSI		No additional conditions imposed
Lymington River SSSI		No access to within 5m of the bank top. Restrict vehicles to existing tracks and do not allow vehicles to use the river bank top for access. Limit location of traps to existing sett footprint. Delay until after hay cut, mid-July
Quarley Hill Fort SSSI		Restrict vehicles to existing tracks. Limit location of traps to within sett footprint or on improved/ semi-improved grassland/scrub areas
The New Forest SSSI	The New Forest SAC, SPA and Ramsar	Exclude SSSI or restrict shooting activities to outside the bird breeding season (so no activities until the 1st September). Avoid areas within 1km of known, or new, Hen harrier roost sites. Limit location of traps to existing sett footprint away from watercourses, wetland or mire areas and more than 250 metres from any pond. Avoid placing traps in any area of known Wild Galdioli populations. No access to within 5m of the bank top. Restrict vehicles to existing tracks and do not allow vehicles to use the river bank top for access. Any decaying wood located within the sett footprint is to be left in situ if possible. If decaying wood must be moved it should be moved no further than is necessary. Exclude SSSI Unit 210 from all operations/access. Avoid digging in areas habitat suitable for reptile hibernation between November and March

Toyd Down and Quarry SSSI		Restrict vehicles to existing tracks. Limit location of traps to within sett footprint or on improved/ semi-improved grassland/scrub areas
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
