FOOTNOTES

This collection has received approval from the Standardisation Committee for Care Information (SCCI), the new national gateway body for care information collection requests.

1. Data are provisional and represent 64.3% of all GP practices in England responding to the October 2014 survey compared with 87.9% of practices in the same survey month in 2013/14. Where a total for England is quoted, (eg sum of number of patients registered and number vaccinated) this is taken from the 64.3% GP practice sample and is therefore NOT an extrapolated figure for all of England.

2. Due to an IT supplier system error, data extracted from GP systems via TPP (System One) is not included in this month's data collection.

4. The age under 65 clinical at-risk group data includes pregnant women with other risk factors but excludes otherwise 'healthy' pregnant women and carers.

5. These data include all women already pregnant or becoming pregnant (in the first, second or third trimesters) as diagnosed by a medical professional from 1 September 2014.

Accurately identifying this denominator is challenging and denominators may be regarded as over-inclusive as they may include women that become eligible and then ineligible before they are vaccinated. Vaccine uptake for pregnant women is likely to be underestimated.

6. The 2014/15 survey and data set has been modified to include all four years old (but not five years or older) including at-risk groups.

7. New optional dataset categories for Gender and Ethnicity are not included in this month's data collection due to an IT system error.

All figures are derived from data as extracted from records on GP systems or as submitted by GP practices or Area Teams and CCGs.

FOOTNOTES

This collection has received approval from the Standardisation Committee for Care Information (SCCI), the new national gateway body for care information collection requests.

1. Data are provisional and represent 64.3% of all GP practices in England responding to the October 2014 survey compared with 87.9% of practices in the same survey month in 2013/14. Where a total for England is quoted, (eg sum of number of patients registered and number vaccinated) this is taken from the 64.3% GP practice sample and is therefore NOT an extrapolated figure for all of England.

2. Due to an IT supplier system error, data extracted from GP systems via TPP (System One) could not be included in this month's data collection.

4. The age under 65 clinical at-risk group data includes pregnant women with other risk factors but excludes otherwise 'healthy' pregnant women and carers.

5. These data include all women already pregnant or becoming pregnant (in the first, second or third trimesters) as diagnosed by a medical professional from 1 September 2014.

Accurately identifying this denominator is challenging and denominators may be regarded as over-inclusive as they may include women that become eligible and then ineligible before they are vaccinated. Vaccine uptake for pregnant women is likely to be underestimated.

6. The 2014/15 survey and data set has been modified to include all four years old (but not five years or older) including at-risk groups.

7. New optional dataset categories for Gender and Ethnicity are not included in this month's data collection due to an IT system error.

This collection has received approval from the Standardisation Committee for Care Information (SCCI), the new national gateway body for care information collection requests.

1. Data are provisional and represent 64.3% of all GP practices in England responding to the October 2014 survey compared with 87.9% of practices in the same survey month in 2013/14. Where a total for England is quoted, (eg sum of number of patients registered and number vaccinated) this is taken from the 64.3% GP practice sample and is therefore NOT an extrapolated figure for all of England.

2. Due to an IT supplier system error, data extracted from GP systems via TPP (System One) could not be included in this month's data collection.

4. The age under 65 clinical at-risk group data includes pregnant women with other risk factors but excludes otherwise 'healthy' pregnant women and carers.

5. These data include all women already pregnant or becoming pregnant (in the first, second or third trimesters) as diagnosed by a medical professional from 1 September 2014. Accurately identifying this denominator is challenging and denominators may be regarded as over-inclusive as they may include women that become eligible and then ineligible before they are vaccinated. Vaccine uptake for pregnant women is likely to be underestimated.

6. The 2014/15 survey and data set has been modified to include all four years old (but not five years or older) including at-risk groups.

7. New optional dataset categories for Gender and Ethnicity are not included in this month's data collection due to an IT system error.

FOOTNOTES

This collection has received approval from the Standardisation Committee for Care Information (SCCI), the new national gateway body for care information collection requests.

1. Data are provisional and represent 64.3% of all GP practices in England responding to the October 2014 survey compared with 87.9% of practices in the same survey month in 2013/14. Where a total for England is quoted, (eg sum of number of patients registered and number vaccinated) this is taken from the 64.3% GP practice sample and is therefore NOT an extrapolated figure for all of England.

2. Due to an IT supplier system error, data extracted from GP systems via TPP (System One) could not be included in this month's data collection.

4. The age under 65 clinical at-risk group data includes pregnant women with other risk factors but excludes otherwise 'healthy' pregnant women and carers.

5. These data include all women already pregnant or becoming pregnant (in the first, second or third trimesters) as diagnosed by a medical professional from 1 September 2014.

Accurately identifying this denominator is challenging and denominators may be regarded as over-inclusive as they may include women that become eligible and then ineligible before they are vaccinated. Vaccine uptake for pregnant women is likely to be underestimated.

6. The 2014/15 survey and data set has been modified to include all four years old (but not five years or older) including at-risk groups.

7. New optional dataset categories for Gender and Ethnicity are not included in this month's data collection due to an IT system error.
