FOOTNOTES

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1. Data is final and represent 96.5% of all GP practices in England responding to the November 2015 survey compared with 96.1% of practices in the same survey month in 2014/15 Where a total for England is quoted (e.g. sum of number of patients registered and number vaccinated) this is taken from the 96.5% GP practice sample and is therefore NOT an extrapolated figure for all of England.

3. The age under 65 clinical at-risk group data includes pregnant women with other risk factors but excludes otherwise 'healthy' pregnant women and carers.
4. These data include all women already pregnant or becoming pregnant (in the first, second or third trimesters) as diagnosed by a medical professional from 1 September 2015. Accurately identifying this denominator is challenging and denominators may be regarded as over-inclusive as they may include women that become eligible and then ineligible before they are vaccinated. Vaccine uptake for pregnant women is likely to be underestimated.

All figures are derived from data as extracted from records on GP systems or as submitted by GP practices or Area Teams and CCGs.
