Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Order has been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Order.

The **start date** for the above Order is 17 October 2018.

Consideration of the Order will take the form of a public local inquiry.

The Inquiry will be held at Mungrisdale Village Hall, Mungrisdale, Cumbria CA11 OXR on Tuesday 2 April 2019 at 10.00am.

The effect of the Order, if confirmed without modifications, will be to modify the Definitive Map and Statement for the area by showing the public road C3033 from Mosedale (NY 357 324) north-eastwards to the Berrier/Hesket road (NY 367 335) via Carrhead Ford (NY 363 333) as a restricted byway, partly modifying the current footpath FP 348002 which runs over parts of this road, as shown on the plan attached to the Order.

Within 8 weeks of the start date [by 12 December 2018]

The Order Making Authority must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a copy (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices) to everyone who has made an objection or representation and the applicant and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order.

Within 14 weeks of the start date [by 23 January 2019]

Everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Inquiry must ensure their statement of case¹ is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send full copies

to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to the applicant, every person who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

Within the same period the applicant (if applicable) must ensure their statement of case is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send a full copy to the Authority. Copies will also be sent to everyone who has made an objection or representation and any other person who has written to us in respect of the Order (excluding copies of any supporting documents - these will be available to view at the Authority's offices).

4 weeks before the date of the inquiry [by 5 March 2019]

The Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant (if applicable) and anyone who wishes to give evidence at the Inquiry must ensure their proof of evidence (together with any summary) is received by the Secretary of State. As soon as possible after the deadline, the Secretary of State will send copies of:

- i) the Authority's proof of evidence to everyone who has made an objection or representation, the applicant and anyone who has submitted a statement of case (excluding copies of any supporting documents – although none should be submitted with a proof of evidence);
- ii) the applicant's proof of evidence to the Authority, everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone else who has submitted a statement of case (excluding copies of any supporting documents although none should be submitted with a proof of evidence); and
- iii) all other proofs of evidence to the Authority, the applicant, everyone who has made an objection or representation and anyone else who has submitted a statement of case (excluding copies of any supporting documents – although none should be submitted with a proof of evidence).

All parties must keep to the timetable set out above and ensure that statements of case and proofs of evidence are received by the Secretary of State on time. Late documents will be returned.

This order is made by the Lake District National Park Authority ("the Authority") by virtue of an agreement between the Authority and Cumbria County Council whereby the Council delegated to the Authority its powers of surveying and modification under the provisions of the Wildlife and Countryside Act 1981 ("the Act") in respect of the administrative area of the Lake District National Park.

The order is made pursuant to the provisions of Section 53 (2) (b) of the Act because it appears to the Authority that the Cumbria County Council Definitive Map and Statement require modification in consequence of the occurrence of an event specified in Sections 53(3)(c)(i) & (ii), namely the discovery by the Authority of evidence which (when considered with all other relevant evidence available to them) shows that (i) a right of way which is not shown in the Map and Statement subsists or is reasonably alleged to subsist as a restricted byway, and (ii) a highway shown in the map and statement as a highway of a particular description ought to be there shown as a highway of a different description.

The Authority has consulted with every local authority whose area includes the land to which the order relates. The Authority hereby orders that:

- 1 For the purposes of this order the relevant date shall be 10 October 2017.
- 2 The Cumbria County Council Definitive Map and Statement shall be modified as described in the Schedule and shown on the plan attached to the order.

This order shall take effect on the date it is confirmed and may be cited as the Lake District National Park Authority Definitive Map Modification Order 2017, Restricted Byway 348043 along the public road C3033, Mosedale and Carrhead Ford, Mungrisdale Parish, and is dated 31 October 2017.
