13 Insurance

You must have in force an insurance policy for the boat, provided by a company that is authorised and regulated by the UK Financial Services Authority, which covers third-party liabilities of at least one million pounds. The insurance must be valid for the full duration of the registration. We do not need a copy of the insurance certificate, but we carry out sample checks on declarations.

14 Boat safety – construction and equipment standards

You must make sure your boat complies with our construction and equipment standards at all times it is kept, let for hire or used on the River Thames.

These standards are set out in the BSS Examination Checking Procedures for Privately Owned and Managed Boats and for hire boats the additional BSS Hire Boats Requirements. For other non-private boats, for example

- small passenger boats
- shared-ownership boats managed jointly by the private owners
- workboats
- emergency service boats and rescue boats
- hotel boats, boats let as residences or longer term accommodation, for example advertising a cabin aboard, or even the whole boat, as rentable accommodation

they are contained in the Boat Safety Scheme Guide (2002 edition).

I confirm that I have read the Boat Safety Scheme Requirements. I certify that the boat complies in every respect with the safety standard requirements set out in those guides or the Recreational Craft Directive. I will not keep or use this boat on the River Thames unless these conditions are complied with.

I understand that the Environment Agency may require me to provide information confirming compliance with these conditions or to require my boat to be inspected.

How we use your personal information

We are the Environment Agency and we manage the boat registration service. We are the data controller for this service. A data controller determines how and why personal data (also called 'personal information') is processed.

The data we need

The personal data we collect includes:

- Names, addresses and contact details

We are allowed to process your personal data because we have official authority to issue boat registrations for the waterways where we are the navigation authority. The lawful basis for processing your personal data is to perform a task in the public interest that is set out in law.

If you do not give us the personal data requested then we will not be able to process your boat registration application.

What we do with your data

We use your personal data to take payment, issue a suitable boat registration and make sure conditions of the registration are met. We will also contact you with important information relating to your registration, boat safety, navigation and environmental matters.

We may use the personal information you give us to:

- consult with you on registration, boat safety, navigation and environmental issues
- ask for your feedback on our service

We will share your personal data with our design, mailing and email service providers to allow delivery of your registration renewal and eNewsletters. These service providers are data processors.

We may also share your data with a data processor to ask for your feedback or to take part in consultations. Data processors working on our behalf will only use your personal data in line with this privacy notice.

We do not use your data to make an automated decision or for automated profiling.

How long we keep your data

We will keep your personal data for 7 years after the registration period has expired, in line with our information retention policy.

Where your personal data is processed and stored

We store and process your personal data on our servers in the UK.

We will not transfer the personal data that you provide outside the European Economic Area.

We aim to process your application as quickly as possible. At busy times it can take up to 10 working days from the day of receipt. Please also allow 2 to 3 days for postage.

If you need the registration more quickly, you can call us and pay by credit/debit card. We will email you confirmation the same day.

Explanatory notes

1 Boat name

It is a registration requirement that every boat must have a name. This name must be displayed on each side of the bow and on the stern in plain letters and figures in the following minimum sizes:

- 2" (5.1cm) for a boat not more than 20' (6.09m) long.
- 3" (7.6cm) for a boat between 20' (6.09m) and 30' (9.14m) long.
- 4" (10.2cm) for a boat between 30' (9.14m) and 50' (15.23m) long.
- 6" (15.2cm) for a boat exceeding 50' (15.23m).

It is acceptable for owners of narrowboats to display the boat name in the traditional way on each side of the cabin.

The Environment Agency is forbidden to register two or more boats in the same name.

2 Registered owner

Only one person or organisation may be registered as the owner.

3 Dimensions

Please enter length and beam measurements in metres and tenths. 'Length' is overall hull length excluding moveable items such as rudder or outboard engine. 'Beam' is measured at the widest part of the hull (use tables on page 4 to help convert your dimensions into metres and tenths).

6 Registration period

Please note each period of validity begins and ends at midnight. The number of 1 day and 7 day certificates are unlimited but only three 31 day certificates can be issued in any calendar year.

7 Manufacturer or builder

Please enter make or model, if known.

8 Propulsion

Where the main engine(s) is of the outdrive/sterndrive type, tick the 'inboard' box.

9/10 Propellant

Tick the appropriate box for the engine propellant, or specify another propellant in the 'other' box.

12 Sanitary facilities

Boats fitted with a lavatory or sanitary holding tank capable of discharge to the river must have these appliances sealed to prevent discharge whilst the boat is on the Thames. Owners of boats fitted with such appliances are legally obliged to inform the lock-keeper at the lock nearest to the boat's point of entry to the river in order that arrangements for sealing can be made.

15 Tender discount

If your main boat is registered, a 50% discount applies to the tender. We define a tender as a small boat or dinghy, towed or carried by another boat.

16 Payment

Registration charges are based on the area of your boat, calculated in square metres by multiplying the length by the beam (width).

Please refer to the separate charges sheet for the current rates.

Registration

All boats kept and used on the Thames are registered in accordance with the Environment Agency (Inland Waterways) Order 2010.

'Full rate' registration and 'late' registration application forms can be obtained from our website or call us (see contacts).

No separate lock tolls are charged on boats currently registered (except certain passenger boats).

Payments made for short period registration of a boat can be deducted from the charges due for any subsequent full rate registration of that boat.

Please note that a boat which is short period registered at any time between 1 Jan and 31 Aug is not eligible for the late registration charge concession.

Visiting from Anglian and Medway waterways

Boats which have current annual registration issued from the above Environment Agency waterways can visit the Thames free of charge for two periods of 7 consecutive days.

If visiting from Environment Agency Anglian or Medway waterways and claiming your free Thames visit, please make sure you fully complete Section 1 with the appropriate authority's registration or licence number for the boat to ensure you receive your free entitlement.

Please note that this concession is only available to boats in private use. No allowance can be made for any non-use on the Thames during your concessionary registration period.

The Thames – definition

The registration requirements of the Environment Agency (Inland Waterways) Order 2010 apply to 'the Thames' within the meaning of section 4 of the Thames Conservancy Act 1932.

This explains 'the Thames' means the parts of the Rivers Thames and Isis between Town Bridge, Cricklade, Wiltshire and an imaginary line drawn across the river 242 metres downstream of Teddington Lock; and also the part of the River Kennet between the point it flows into the Thames and an imaginary line drawn across the river 64 metres downstream of the High Bridge, Reading. It also means all locks, cuts and works within these waterways (which includes basins and marinas).
