

Thank you for your letter of 26th July 2018 requesting the following information:

Who supplies the official watches for the army and what models does the military officially use?

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that information in scope of your request is held.

The information you have requested can be found below, but some of the information falls entirely within the scope of the absolute exemption provided for at section 23 (bodies dealing with Security Matters) of the FOIA and has been withheld.

Section 23(1) is applicable to any information supplied by, or relating to, any of the bodies named in section 23(3) of the Act. Section 23 is an absolute exemption and there is therefore no requirement to consider the public interest in making a decision to withhold the information.
