

Pre-Release Access List: Local authority and children's homes in England inspections and outcomes

The phrase 'Pre-release Access' refers to the practice whereby official statistics in their final form, and any accompanying written commentary, are made available to an eligible person in advance of their publication. The rules and principles which govern pre-release access are featured within the Pre-release Access to Official Statistics Order 2008.

The data contained in the statistical release has been used by Ofsted for operational reasons meaning access to this data has been available to a number of Ofsted employees for the purpose of meeting business needs and discharging functions. Access to this statistical release has not been given to the Ofsted employees referred to in the previous paragraph and, with the exception of the analysts who produce the output, only individuals included in the list below have been given 24 hour pre-release access before release.
