We are treating your e-mail as a request for information in accordance with the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA 2000).

In your e-mail you requested the following information:

"I would like the following data for the end of the 2009/2010 financial year (ie correct as of March/April 2010) and the most recent available figures, ideally correct at this moment in time.

- 1. Total number of staff employed by the force
- 2. Total number of police officers split between full time and part time
- 3. Total number of civilian staff split between full time and part time
- 4. Overall annual spend on wages

I would also like:

- 5. A list of posts that existed in 2010 but do not exist in 2018
- 6. A list of posts that exist in 2018 but did not exist in 2010"

A search for information has now been completed by the Ministry of Defence Police and I can confirm that we do hold information in scope of your request. (Note: these figures are based on headcount.)
