

## Thames and Blackwater Herring Licence: Schedule (23)

---

### AUTHORITY

1. Subject to the limitations set out below, and to any prohibition on fishing imposed by order under Section 5 of the Sea Fish (Conservation) Act 1967 (as amended) or by the European Commission under the provisions of Article 35 of Council Regulation (EEC) No 1224/2009 (as amended), this licence hereby authorises the above-named vessel to fish by the drift net method only for the descriptions of sea fish listed in Column 1 below in the sea areas set out in Column 2 below.

Herring

The area of sea within a zone delimited by a line running due south from Landguard Point (51° 56' North and 1° 19.1' East) to 51° 33' North and thence due west to a point on the coast of England.

### LIMITATIONS TO AUTHORITY

2. This licence is valid from 00:01 hours on 1 January 2019 subject to any revocation, suspension or variation.

3.1 This licence may be revoked, suspended or varied at any time, by a notice communicated in accordance with The Sea Fishing (Licence and Notices) (England) Regulation 2012 or, in the case of a vessel administered in Wales or Northern Ireland, The Sea Fishing (Licences & Notices) Regulations 1994.

3.2 In accordance with regulation 3(3)(b) of The Sea Fishing (Licence and Notices) (England) Regulation 2012, notices will be published on the [www.gov.uk](http://www.gov.uk) website at:

The licence shall also cease to have effect if by virtue of an Order of the Court the licensee has been disqualified from holding a licence in respect of the vessel

### QUOTA LIMITATIONS

5. **The Total Allowable Catch has been set at 10 tonnes, the fishery will be closed when this quantity of herring has been taken**
