ANNEX 1

TO CLAIMANT'S STATEMENT OF GROUNDS FOR AMENDMENT OF GB 2,365,712

CLAIMS

1. A <u>computing devicesmart phone</u> comprising a display screen, the <u>computing devicesmart</u> phone being <u>able-configured</u> to display on the screen a main hierarchical menu system,

wherein the <u>devicesmart phone</u> is also <u>able configured</u> to display, in addition to the main hierarchical menu system, application summary windows for each of several different applications,

in which each summary window serves as <u>a</u> summary of a particular application by virtue of displaying a limited list of (i) several commonly used functions offered within that particular application and/or (ii) stored data commonly accessed by that particular application.

wherein the smart phone is configured to, for a given application:

display, in a summary window for the given application, both a limited list of several commonly used functions offered within the given application and stored data commonly accessed by the given application;

display the said commonly used functions offered within the given application without opening the given application;

display the said stored data commonly accessed by the given application without opening the given application; and

open the given application when an item of the said displayed commonly used functions or the said displayed stored data is selected.

- 2. The <u>computing devicesmart phone</u> of Claim 1 in which selecting a common<u>ly used</u> function listed in the summary window causes the <u>related_given_application</u> to open and that selected common<u>ly used</u> function to be activated.
- 3. The <u>computing devicesmart phone</u> of Claim 1 or 2 in which an application launcher lists the names and/or icons of several applications and selecting a name or icon causes the summary window for <u>that the given</u> application to be opened.
- 4. The <u>computing devicesmart phone</u> of any preceding claim in which the kinds of content of <u>thea</u> summary window for <u>thea</u> given application is selected using a process in which the

devicesmart phone learns what functionality and/or stored data types are of interest to any given user.

- 5. The <u>computing devicesmart phone</u> of any preceding claim in which the user can define what functionality and/or stored data types are of interest to that user for the summary window for an the given application.
- 6. The <u>computing devicesmart phone</u> of any preceding claim in which <u>the smart phone is</u> <u>configured to vary</u> the functionality and/or stored data types for <u>thea</u> summary window for <u>thea</u> given application <u>varies</u> with the environment of the <u>devicesmart phone</u>.
- 7. The <u>computing devicesmart phone</u> of any preceding claim in which the <u>smart phone is</u> <u>configured to vary the functionality and/or stored data types for thea</u> summary window for <u>thea</u> given application <u>varies</u> with the actions of the user.
- 8. The <u>computing devicesmart phone</u> of any preceding claim in which opening <u>thea</u> summary window for thea given application does not result in <u>that</u> the given application being opened.
- 9. The <u>computing devicesmart phone</u> of any preceding claim in which the summary window is a frame which includes the name of the <u>associated given</u> application.
- 10. The <u>eomputing devicesmart phone</u> of <u>Claim 1 any preceding claim</u> in which the summary window <u>further displays</u> a <u>limited</u> list of <u>stored data commonly accessed by the given application data stored in that application.</u>
- 11. A computing device as claimed in any preceding claim, being a mobile telephone.
- 12. A computing device as claimed in any preceding claim 1—10, being a PC.
- 11. The smart phone of any preceding claim in which the given application is a messages application.

- 123. A computer program which, when running on a <u>smart phone computing device</u>, causes the <u>smart phone computing device</u> to operate as a <u>smart phone computing device</u> as claimed in <u>any of Claims 1 to-112</u>.
- $1\underline{34}$. The computer program of Claim $1\underline{32}$, being an operating system program.
