7 Regulation Director's update on key issues

- 09/02/14 The Director of Regulation updated Committee on key developments since the last Committee meeting. Particular note was taken of the following points:
- 10/02/14 Value for Money: The Director of Regulation confirmed that 14 registered providers had been downgraded on governance for not meeting the Value for Money standard.
- 11/02/14 Media coverage and Stakeholders: The Director of Regulation noted that current activity included Fees, Global Account and the Cosmopolitan review. On stakeholder engagement, he and David Orr were planning to send a joint letter to the Chief Executives of Registered Providers regarding Code of Governance compliance and board renewal. He AGREED to circulate a copy to Members.
