Illegal Posting of Advertising Posters

I would draw your attention to the present situation with regard to the siting of advertising boards and posters on the highway.

Under Section 132 of the Highways Act 1980, it is an offence to affix any sign on any structure on the Highway without obtaining consent of the Highway Authority. Such an offence is punishable by a maximum fine of £2,500.

The Authority has, in recent weeks, removed posters from the Highway bearing your or your organisations name. It may be that you were not aware that any organisation, company or venue referred to or indicated on such a poster, can be held responsible under the said Act.

Subject to your agreement that you will not post or have posted any more signs on any street furniture, trees or monuments, no further action will be taken.

I must however, forewarn you that it is my intention to have removed any such posters and signs from the City Centre and that action will be taken against any individual or company found repeating this offence.

I trust I can rely on your co-operation in this matter.
