

Authorise a representative

A representative is anyone you want to represent you in a tax tribunal case. Your representative will deal with all correspondence and can go to a hearing with you to speak on your behalf.

This form is not required if your representative is a practising solicitor or barrister in England, Wales or Northern Ireland, or a practising solicitor or advocate in Scotland.
