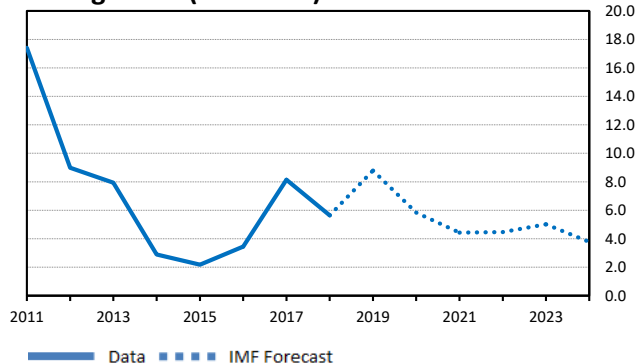

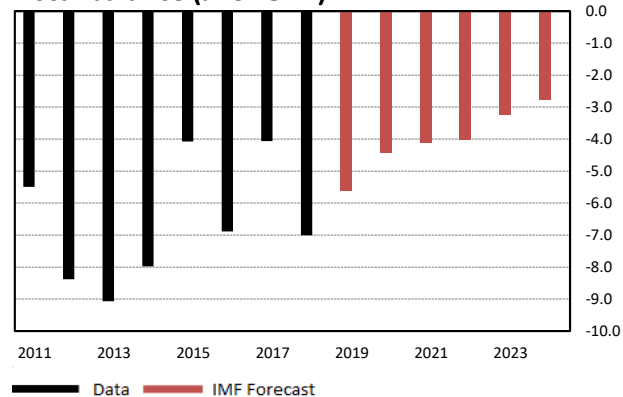

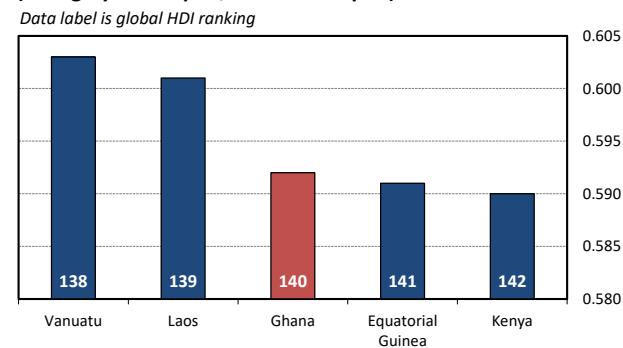
GDP growth (annual %)*



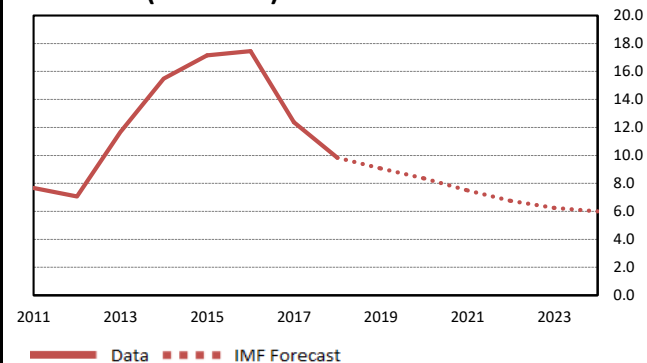
Fiscal balance (% of GDP)*



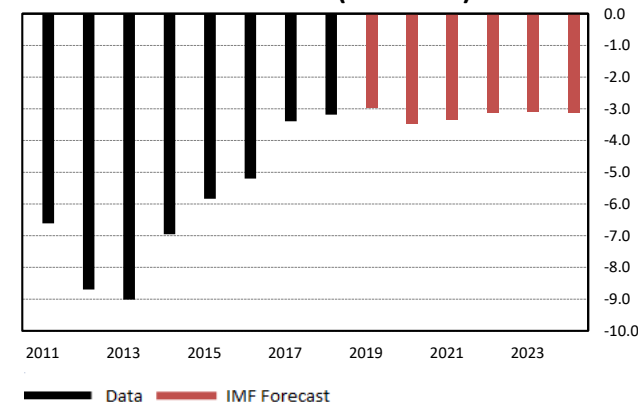
Human Development Index (1= highly developed, 0= undeveloped)



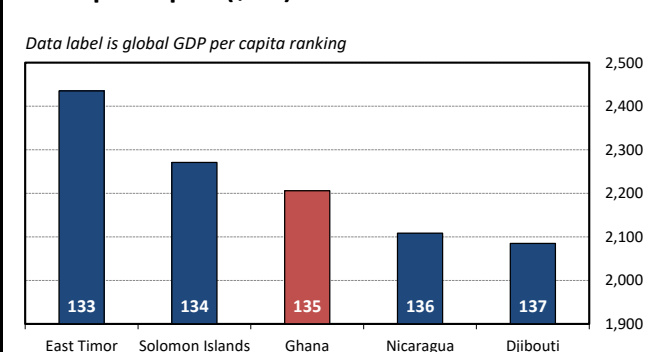
Inflation (annual %)*
