"Are the a) Head of Defence Logistic Policy b) Head of Defence Logistic Strategy c) Head Defence Intelligence Operations d) Head of Networks, Information Services and Systems still active appointments, and if so, could you name the officers holding these appointments? (ref https://www.gov.uk/government/publications/mod-roles-and-salaries-2018)

If you cannot provide the names, could you state which of the three services they are from, that is, Royal Navy/Royal Marines, British Army or Royal Air Force?"

I am treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

A search for the information has now been completed within the Ministry of Defence, and I can confirm that all the information in scope of your request is held.

The information you have requested can be found below:

- a) The Head of Defence Logistic Policy is no longer an active post.
- b) Brigadier Martin Moore is currently the Head of Defence Logistic Strategy.
- c) The Defence Intelligence Operations Head is currently not an active post.
- d) Julian Knight is the Head of Networks, Information Services and Systems.

Please note that any request for an internal review must be made within 40 working days of the date on which the attempt to reach informal resolution has come to an end.

If you remain dissatisfied following an internal review, you may take your complaint to the Information Commissioner under the provisions of Section 50 of the Freedom of Information Act. Please note that the Information Commissioner will not normally investigate your case until the MOD internal review process has been completed.
