Freedom of Information Act 2000: Residential investment transactions 2015-2019

Thank you for your enquiry of 7 February 2019, which we have considered under the terms of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (the FOI Act).

You asked for the following information:

"We are in the process of determining the size of the residential investment market in the UK and require some assistance and information from yourselves under the Freedom of Information Act.

Please could you provide us with the following information.

- 1. Individual sale prices and addresses for residential blocks over 5-units.
- 2. Sold between 2015 and 2019.
- 3. Value above £5m.

It is worth noting that this may well fall under commercial stamp duty transactions."

Following a search of our records, I can confirm that HM Treasury does not hold information within the scope of your request. It may be helpful to explain that HM Treasury does not routinely collect or hold any detailed information about individual residential or non-residential property developments or transactions.
