Notice is hereby given that the above referenced Orders have been submitted to the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs for determination. An Inspector will be appointed by the Secretary of State to determine the Orders.

The start date for the above Orders is 25 June 2019.

Consideration of the Orders will take the form of a public local inquiry.

The Inquiry will be held at Yorkshire Children's Centre, Brian Jackson House, New North Parade, Huddersfield, HD1 5JP on Tuesday 21 January 2020 at 10.00am.

The effect of the Orders, if confirmed without modifications, will be to: -

1) Public Path Stopping Up Order 2018

Stop up six public footpaths:

Huddersfield 477 commencing at its junction with Huddersfield 345 at point A grid reference 1321 1776 and proceeding in an easterly direction for 346 metres to point B at grid reference 1352 1771;

Huddersfield 478 commencing at its junction with Edgerton Road at point C at grid reference 1320 1760 and proceeding via point F at grid reference 1325 1762 in a north easterly direction for 257 metres via point G at grid reference 1340 1774 to point I at grid reference 1341 1774 with a link of a distance of 11 metres from point G grid reference 1340 1774 to point H at grid reference 1341 1775;

Huddersfield 479 commencing at its junction with Edgerton Road at point E at grid reference 1322 1759 and proceeding in a north easterly direction for 42 metres to point F at grid reference 1325 1762;




