## *The Non-Central Government market is mobilised and motivated for PSN .....*

- The document presents a published set of high level roadmaps for Non-Central Government PSN initiatives.
- These 36 PSN initiatives involve collaborations between Local Government, Fire Services, Police Forces and Health Trusts and therefore represent well over 200 organisations.
- **During 2012/13 and 2013/14, the introduction of increasing numbers of PSN compliant services, wide-scale adoption of the PSN national procurement frameworks and the transition of central services (e.g. GCF) to PSN, will drive further PSN adoption both within and outside the regional partnership context.**
- 23 Regional PSN initiatives (highlighted in Green) have procured and implemented PSN networks that have been accredited or are formally progressing PSN accreditation .
  - At present benefits are accruing from aggregation and shared services at the regional level but the increasing national availability of accredited PSN services across the GCN and the establishment of the PSN Services Frameworks will enable partner organisations to further exploit their PSN capability.

- 13 further PSN initiatives are progressing procurement and implementation of PSN network environments.
- Publication has been agreed with 24 initiatives which are named. There are a further 12 roadmaps that are currently anonymous until approval to publish them has been received.
- The roadmaps state the potential number and type of partner organisations that will adopt PSN via each PSN initiative.
- Further publications will be issued on a regular basis.

***We are supporting PSN adoption through a highly proactive direct engagement approach aimed at:***

- Achieving a clear and common understanding of the PSN and how it can be procured and adopted.
- Providing guidance and support to enable organisations to adopt and begin operating over PSN at the earliest opportunity.
- Demonstrating the key opportunities for delivering services more efficiently and effectively through the use of PSN.
- Raising awareness and understanding of the National Frameworks that will provide PSN services.
- We are engaging widely through delivery and support of regional events around the country and are providing targeted support to organisations seeking to re-procure telecommunications services in the near future.
- We are also working closely with the Central Government transition team and the Local CIO Council to ensure Central Government plans are understood and the opportunity for cross-public sector collaboration is maximised.
