During final quality assurance, we have become aware of a potential concern with the total corporation tax receipts and corporation tax credits data. We are investigating this further and, if appropriate, we plan to revise the estimates for total corporation tax receipts and corporation tax credits in the publication during the w/c 2nd September 2019. This is in line with our published revisions policy of releasing revised statistics if additional information becomes available. 1st May	Estimated costs of principal tax reliefs: Marriage Allowance estimates	<p>The estimates for Marriage Allowance will be re-published shortly. This is in line with our published revisions policy of releasing revised statistics if additional information becomes available.
