## Dear Consultee.

I am writing to invite your views on the implementation in England of the EU Dairy Package (Regulation (EU) no 261/2012 of the European Parliament and of the Council, Commission Implementing Regulation (EU) No 511/2012 and Commission Delegated Regulation (EU) No 880/2012).

We expect this consultation to be of interest to anyone operating in the dairy supply chain from farm, through processing to retail and distribution, in particular anyone involved in the production, purchasing or processing of raw milk where the changes we are consulting upon would occur.

We are conducting a very short and direct consultation. We have liaised closely with representatives throughout the dairy supply chain during the last three years whilst these EU Regulations have been established. We believe we have consensus from industry on our proposals. We do not anticipate needing any domestic legislation since the EU Regulations are directly applicable. Following this process will mean that we can implement as quickly as possible the beneficial changes provided by these EU Regulations.
