


Football-related arrests




Clubs with the highest number of supporters arrested

Almost all football banning orders were issued to males (1,765).


18-34s were the age group with the highest number of football banning orders.

Steady decline in football banning orders in force since 2011

19% (+89) increase in new football banning orders imposed

Experimental statistics - Reported incidents at football fixtures

In the 2018/19 season, at **3,022 regulated domestic matches**, there were **1,007** with reported incidents.
