



Our Role




Across the country we work in collaboration with stakeholders who share our ambition.

We have a long-term commitment to placemaking, investment in infrastructure and a track record of delivery. We have the capacity to invest in the lives of residents over the space of several Local Plan periods. Our outlook and resources have unlocked sites elsewhere in the country which were previously stalled, delivering high quality places.

Through the Horsham District Local Plan review process we have submitted our land to the west of Ifield, entered into a planning performance agreement. Our vision is to support the local authorities to secure the opportunity to create the next new neighbourhoods for Crawley, complete with the social, health and transport infrastructure to make it a place which residents will be proud to make their home and existing residents can benefit from.

We will start consulting in November 2019.
