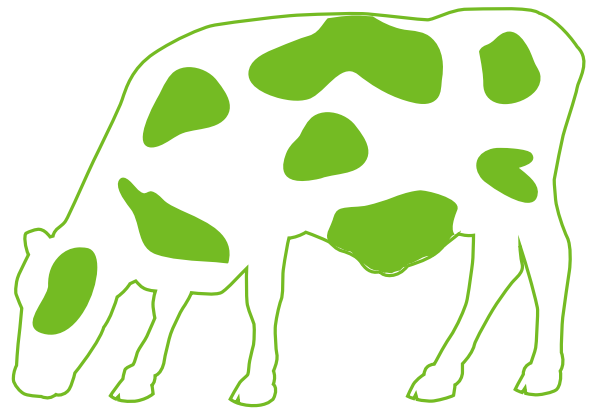

LIVESTOCK AND POULTRY IMPORTERS

**You need to take
new steps to
import livestock
and live poultry
from the EU to the
UK in a no-deal
scenario**



Check what you need to do by following this process.

Start

1.0

Check to see if you have a **UK EORI number**

2.0

Check to see if you can **register** for simplified import procedures

3.0

Check your EU exporter has completed a **commercial document** and an ITAHC/EHC

The EU exporter should send you a copy of the completed commercial document including details of the contents of the consignment, plus the name of the person who sent it and the person it's being sent to.

4.0

Check the rate of **tax and duty** you'll need to pay on your import

If the UK leaves the EU with no deal, new temporary import tariffs and tariff rate quotas will apply and will be in place for up to 12 months.

5.0

Complete an **IV66 form** and email it to APHA (if importing to Great Britain) or DAERA (if importing to Northern Ireland)

The IV66 Import Notification Form should be completed and submitted 30 days to 24 hours prior to import.

6.0

APHA or DAERA email you a unique notification number (UNN). Send the UNN to your exporter to complete their EHC or ITAHC and other documentation

The UNN is usually generated within 24 hours of APHA or DAERA receiving the completed notification form.

7.0

EU exporter sends consignment to you with the relevant paperwork. The EU exporter and transporter must comply with all **live animal transport requirements**. This may include completing a journey log

8.0

Complete an import customs declaration **via your export agent** or **do it yourself**

9.0

Your goods arrive at the pre-notified destination where they may be **checked by UK authorities**

You will have specified the destination of your consignment on your IV66 import notification form.
