 <b>Infanrix hexa (GSK) or Vaxelis (Sanofi)</b> Hexavalent vaccine DTaP/IPV/Hib/HepB	Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis (whooping cough), polio, <i>Haemophilus influenzae</i> type b (Hib) and hepatitis B	8,12,16 weeks
 <b>Rotarix (GSK)</b> Rotavirus (oral)	Rotavirus gastroenteritis	8 weeks and 12 weeks
 <b>Bexsero (GSK)</b> MenB	Meningococcal group B	8 weeks, 16 weeks and 1 year
 <b>Prevenar 13 (Pfizer)</b> Pneumococcal conjugate vaccine (PCV)	Pneumococcal (13 serotypes)	12 weeks and 1 year
 <b>Menitorix (GSK)</b> Hib/MenC	<i>Haemophilus influenzae</i> type b (Hib) and meningococcal group C	1 year
 <b>MMRvaxPro (MSD) or Priorix (GSK)</b> MMR	Measles, mumps and rubella	1 year and 3 years 4 months
 <b>Boostrix-IPV (GSK) or REPEVAX (Sanofi)</b> dTaP/IPV	Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis and polio	3 years 4 months
 <b>Gardasil 9 (MSD)</b> Human papillomavirus vaccine (HPV)	Cancers and genital warts caused by specific human papillomavirus (HPV) types	12 to 13 years (school Year 8)
 <b>REVAXIS (Sanofi)</b> Td/IPV	Tetanus, diphtheria and polio	14 years (school Year 9)
 <b>MenQuadfi (Sanofi)</b> MenACWY	Meningococcal groups A, C, W and Y	14 years (school Year 9)
 <b>ADACEL (Sanofi)</b> Tdap	Tetanus, diphtheria and pertussis	Pregnant women from 16 weeks gestation
 <b>Abrysvo (Pfizer)</b> RSV	Respiratory Syncytial Virus	Pregnant women from 28 weeks gestation 75 years*
 <b>Pneumovax 23 (MSD)</b> Pneumococcal Polysaccharide Vaccine (PPV23)	Pneumococcal (23 serotypes)	65 years (and certain at-risk groups)**
 <b>Shingrix (GSK)</b> Shingles	Shingles	50+ if severely immunosuppressed (no upper age limit) 65 years or 70 years of age*** (remain eligible until their 80 <sup>th</sup> birthday)
