

**HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTIONS 118A AND 120(3)**  
**(FOOTPATH 18, PARISH OF STAINES) BOROUGH OF SPELTHORNE,**  
**SURREY RAIL CROSSING EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2019.**

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs, in exercise of the powers conferred on her under section 118A and 120(3) of the Highways Act 1980 and all other powers enabling her in that behalf, proposes to make an order, the effect of which will be to extinguish the public right of way, in the parish of Staines, public Footpath 18 in the interest of the safety of members of the public using, or likely to use, the said Footpath.

The effect of the Order shall be to extinguish:

The entirety length of public Footpath 18 Parish of Staines commencing at point D at its junction with public Footpaths 17 and 19 south east of Cambridge Kennels at grid reference X:502727.58477 Y:172886.25964 and proceeding in a generally south-south-easterly direction to point C on the eastern side of the railway grid reference X:502752.72024, Y:172791.67091 then crossing the railway in a south-south-westerly direction to point B on the western side of the railway grid reference X:502745.44418, Y:172770.50420, then proceeding in a south-south-westerly then south-south-easterly direction to point A opposite 'The Swan' public house on Moor Lane grid reference X:502742.79834, Y:172695.75926. The length of public Footpath 18, Parish of Staines, is 187 metres.

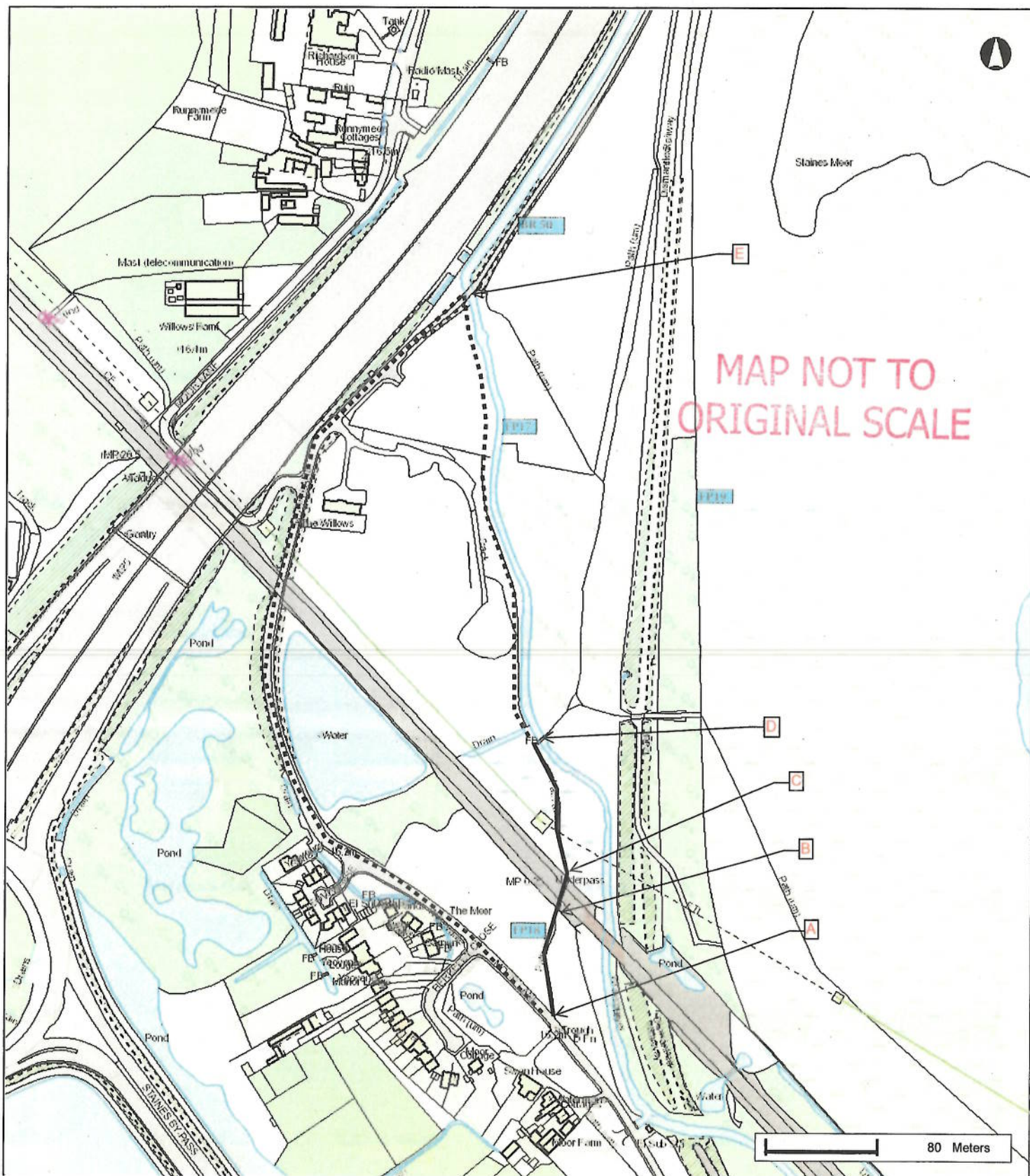
The authority has required the operator of the railway to enter into an agreement with it to defray any expenses which the authority may incur.

**SURREY RAIL CROSSING EXTINGUISHMENT ORDER 2019**

This Order is made by the Secretary of State for Environment, Food and Rural Affairs ("the Secretary of State") under sections 118A and 120(3) of the Highways Act 1980.

The footpath described in paragraph 1 of this Order crosses a railway otherwise than by a tunnel or bridge.

It appears to the Secretary of State that it is expedient in the interests of the safety of members of the public using, or likely to use, the said footpath that it should be stopped up.

All local authorities have been consulted as required by section 120(2) of the 1980 Act.

The Secretary of State has required the operator of the railway to enter into an agreement with the highway authority to defray any expenses which are incurred in the erection or maintenance of barriers and signs.

The map attached to the order shows alternative highways by dashed black lines.

BY THIS ORDER:

The public right of way over the land situate, in the Parish of Staines, in the Borough of Spelthorne in the County of Surrey shown by a bold continuous line on the map attached to this Order and described in the Schedule hereto shall be extinguished after 28 days from the date of confirmation of this Order.

**SCHEDULE**

**DESCRIPTION OF SITE OF RIGHT OF WAY TO BE EXTINGUISHED**

The entirety of the length and width of public Footpath 18, Parish of Staines commencing at point D at its junction with public Footpaths 17 and 19 south east of Cambridge Kennels at grid reference X: 502727.58477

Y: 172886.25964 and proceeding in a generally south-south-easterly direction to point C on the eastern side of the railway grid reference X:502752.72024, Y:172791.67091 then crossing the railway in a south-south-westerly direction to point B on the western side of the railway grid reference X: 502745.44418, Y: 172770.50420, then proceeding in a south-south-westerly then south-south-easterly direction to point A opposite 'The Swan' public house on Moor Lane grid

reference X: 502742.79834, Y: 172695.75926. The length of public Footpath 18, Parish of Staines, is 187 metres.
