

REQUEST FOR INFORMATION - AERIAL IMAGES OF PROPERTY 1950 - 1980

Further to our email dated 4 November, I can confirm that your request has been considered under the provisions of the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOI (A)), and the process is now complete.

You asked for the following:

"Under the Freedom of Information Act, I am requesting any aerial photographs you may have that include my property for the years of 1950 to 1980. My primary interest is how the land and development has changed throughout the years for the area directly adjacent to my property."

Please find enclosed imagery of the requested area, which covers the period 25 March 1968 to 5 September 1974. There is no imagery coverage prior to 1968 or between 1976 to 1980.

You will note that there are markings on the image dated 23 August 1969. Cameras of that era used these markings to make it easy to match the imagery to mapping.

The information supplied to you continues to be protected by the Copyright, Designs and Patents Act 1988. You are free to use it for your own purposes, including any non-commercial research you are doing and for the purposes of news reporting. Any other reuse, for example commercial publication, would require the permission of the copyright holder. Most documents supplied by the Ministry of Defence will have been produced by government officials and will be Crown Copyright.
