Notes

- 1. The Regulations require that seed potatoes are delivered in containers which carry an official label and are sealed before leaving the producer's premises.
- 2. Labels issued are sealed by stitching through, or by the use of a plastic seal or metal thumb seal. Seals will be provided by your local Plant Health & Seeds Inspector.
- 3. There will be an administration fee for the processing of this application and a fee for the production of the labels. There will be a separate fee for the inspection of the tubers
- 4. Varieties entered for, but not yet having achieved National Listing, may only be marketed as Approved Stock for test and trial purposes, providing you have already applied for authorisation to market small quantities and such authorisation has been granted. These labels are orange in colour. Where Approved Stock has not been granted authorisation to market, labels are issued for movement only. These labels are yellow in colour.

Data Protection Act 1998
