4. RWM's Siting and Engagement Director gave an update on the Siting process. She reported that RWM with the NDA has been conducting a series of roadshows with nuclear site stakeholder groups to promote interest the siting process.

5. The Programme Director at RWM advised the board on emerging thinking on the proposals for revising the approach to the business case development for the site characterisation phase of the project and considerations regarding whether a single business case was appropriate for this.

The timing of the business case was also discussed. Work on the appropriate approach was ongoing and no conclusions had been reached yet.

## Item 5 – Progress Report on Property Value Protection

6. The GDF Policy Advisor gave an update on information gathered about the formulation of non-statutory property value protection schemes for Government funded projects. The RWM Siting and Engagement Director reported that RWM is currently carrying out some

financial modelling in relation to property value protection.

7. The Siting and Engagement Director reported that RWM is finalising the Site Evaluation Documents for England and Wales following consultation earlier this year. The Board discussed the final siting evaluation document and the key messages from the consultation responses. RWM expect to publish the documents following designation of the National Policy Statement for Geological Infrastructure in England.
