

### GOVERNMENT-PURCHASED TICKETS

In total, the Government purchased 8,641 tickets for the Olympic Games and Paralympic Games, at a cost of £1,174,421. This was out of the 10.99 million that were sold in total for the Games. Of these, 4,016 tickets, costing £916,474 were paid for and distributed by central Government, less than 0.04% of the total sales.
