Section 2 – impact analysis

Software suppliers' summary of impact assessment

Supplier 1 - We believe that providing a solution for the T Level aspect of School Census that meets the DFE requirement for School Census Autumn 2020 is acceptable and achievable.

However, we feel that this is going to be very difficult to deal with in the very short time available for use in School Census Autumn 2020. Given how few schools are going to make use of T Levels for 2020-21, we wonder if it might be better for all involved if collection of this data via School Census was delayed until School Census Autumn 2021. If it was delayed it might also give the DfE time to come up with a more rational structure for collecting the data, as the current structure is likely to mystify many schools and support organisations.

DfE response - The department appreciates the level of changes required to schools' MIS in preparation for T level reporting. The decision to amend all systems for 2020 rather than put in place an interim solution was not taken lightly. Hence the many meetings with suppliers to define a solution that was achievable prior to Star Chamber agreement. The smooth introduction of T Levels is a high priority for ministers and we will continue to support suppliers in this area in conjunction with our colleagues in the ESFA. Additional guidance including example scenarios will be provided and published on gov.uk. We also invite ideas of anything further we can do that may assist suppliers and their schools.
