Dear

We are writing this letter to you because the amount of your State Pension is going to change in April 2020.

Your State Pension currently includes an Adult Dependency Increase. This is a payment for someone who is financially dependent on you. It is an extra amount paid as part of your State Pension. Since 6 April 2010 no new Adult Dependency Increases have been awarded.

The Pensions Act 2007 removes the Adult Dependency Increase for everyone on 5 April 2020.

What this means for you

Nothing is changing right now. We are letting you know about this future change now so that you can think about making plans.

After 5 April 2020, you will no longer get the Adult Dependency Increase. You will still get your State Pension. But the amount of your State Pension will be lower because it does not include the Adult Dependency Increase.

The rest of your State Pension will continue to be paid as normal.

Your current amount of Adult Dependency Increase is £0.00. This amount will no longer be payable with your State Pension from 6 April 2020. Your Adult Dependency Increase will end on 5 April 2020. This means your State Pension amount will change from that date.
