The types of services include:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- Provision of full hospital capacity and services including acute bed capacity (192 inpatient beds currently identified – further capacity to be included in this arrangement on the same basis by agreement, if and when available), facilities, diagnostics, staffing, management and full organisation capability supplied to the NHS on an open book basis (to include Income and Expenditure as well as balance sheet) for the purpose of supporting the NHS in Wales during its response to the COVID-19 pandemic. Full cost of provision to be funded centrally by NHS in Wales. This arrangement does not include the provision of primary medical care services or community services, whether or not provided from the same facilities.</li> <li>- Providers will comply, from 6 April, with the NHS rules for cancellation and prioritisation of elective care. On and following 6 April 2020 and until notice of de-escalation Providers shall not treat any patients outside of this arrangement save for specifically agreed patients including those with long term neurological conditions and urgent oncology cases and those requiring urgent treatment who had been receiving treatment from Providers immediately prior 6 April 2020.</li> <li>- Across the various stages of Term (as defined below), the service is expected to incorporate the following roles:</li> <li>- A: Inpatient and outpatient (including supporting pathology and imaging), urgent elective and cancer treatment in line with nationally set criteria to offset reduced NHS capacity so the NHS can focus on the most acute cases;</li> <li>- B: Provide NHS in Wales inpatient non-elective care (either direct admission or transfer from the NHS in Wales);</li> <li>- C: Convert day-case only facilities to provide care as per ‘B’;</li> </ul>

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				<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>- D: Provision of NHS care for COVID-19 infected patients needing high dependency respiratory support on oxygen therapy and NIV therapy (+/- ITU).</li> <li>- Patient workflow, case mix, staffing and equipment deployment will be agreed between the parties requiring Providers to offer operational flexibility where possible.</li> <li>- During the term of the arrangement, there will be a mutual best endeavours to maximise coverage and utilisation.</li> <li>- The informal agreement between Providers covered working together to agree a common position in order to simplify the negotiations and to agree a common approach to pricing</li> <li>- As a result of the negotiations individual heads of terms with NHS in Wales, which will be followed up with individual contracts for services on substantially the NHS standard form contract for secondary care.</li> </ul>
