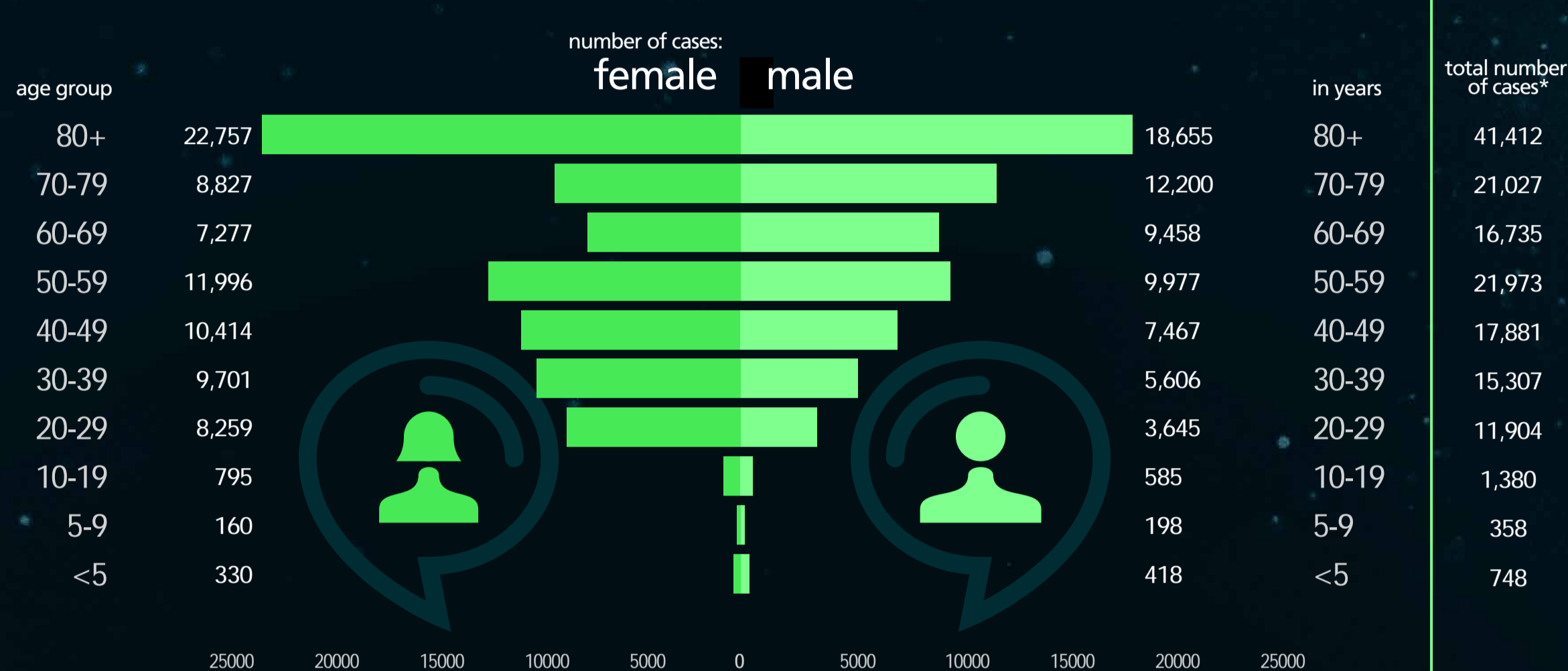

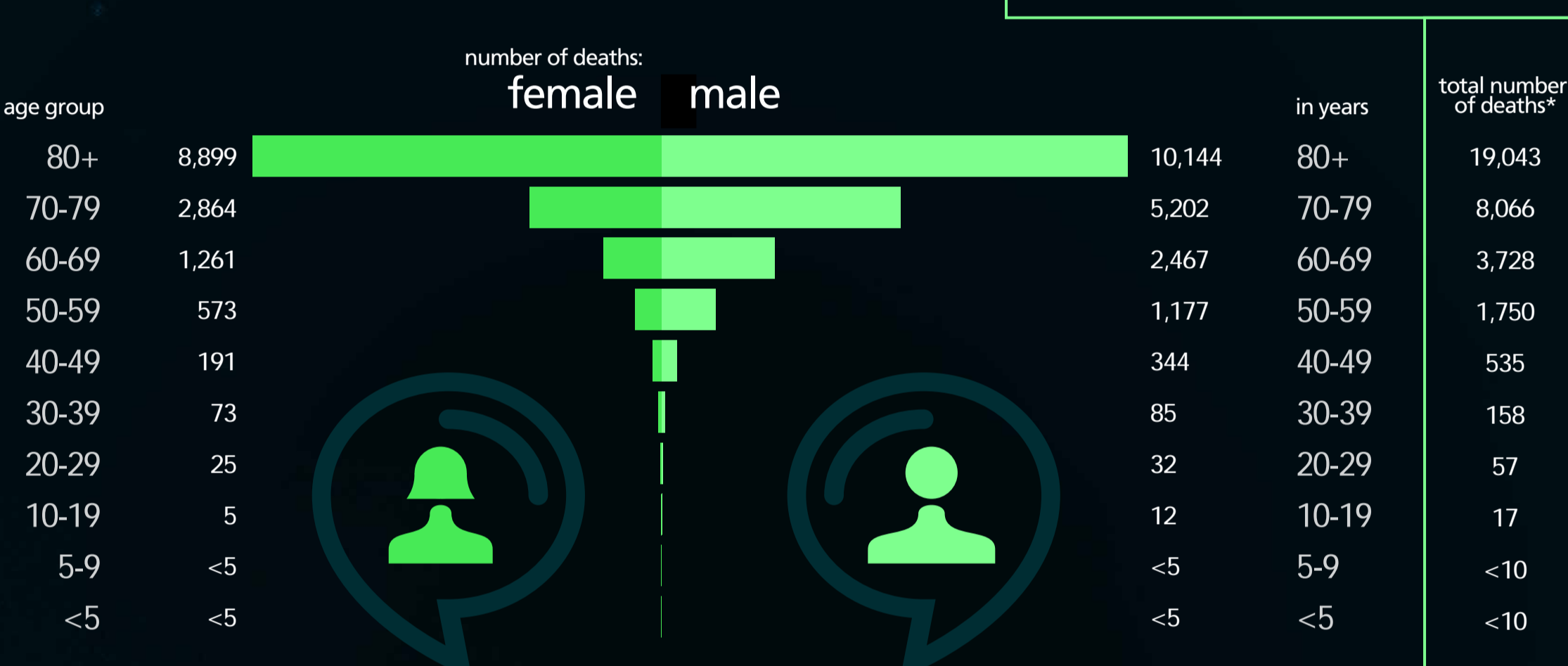
## POPULATION PYRAMID OF CASES

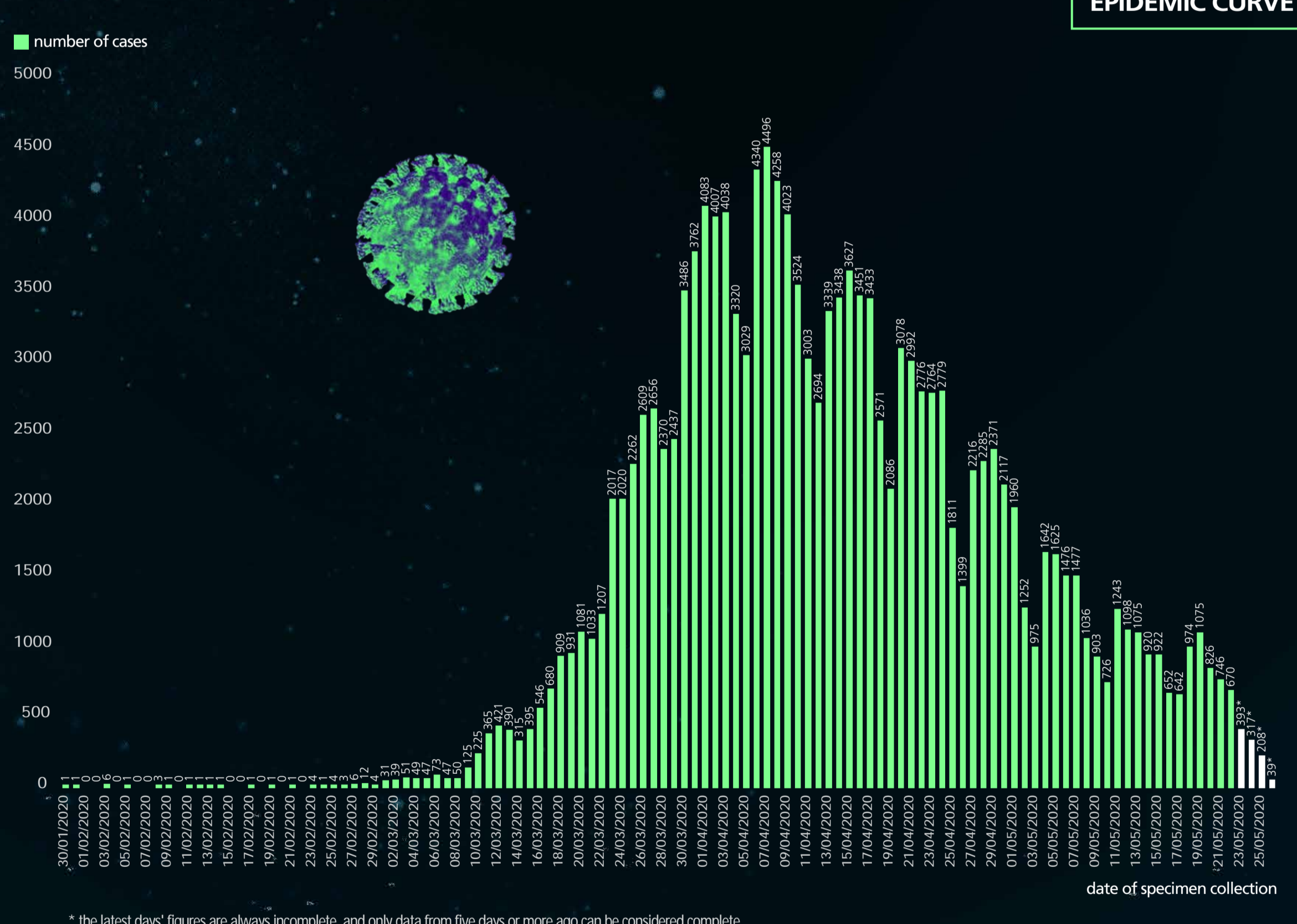

## POPULATION PYRAMID OF DEATHS

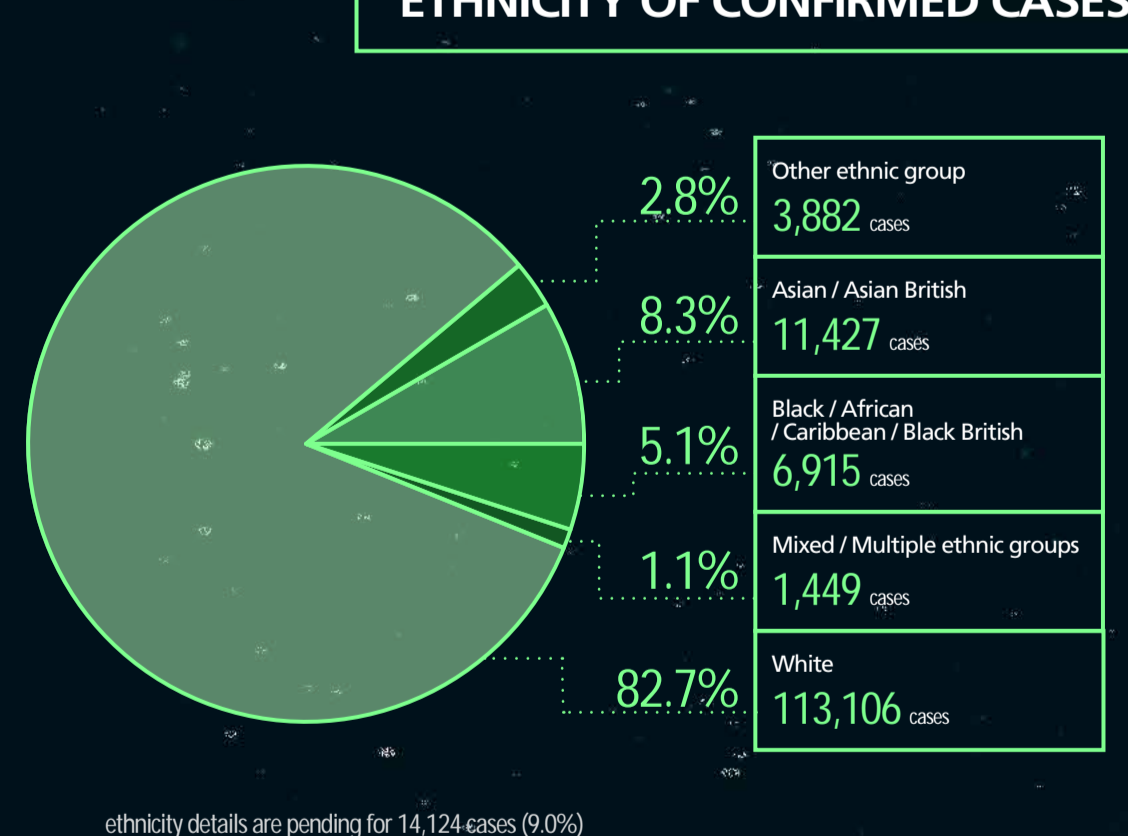

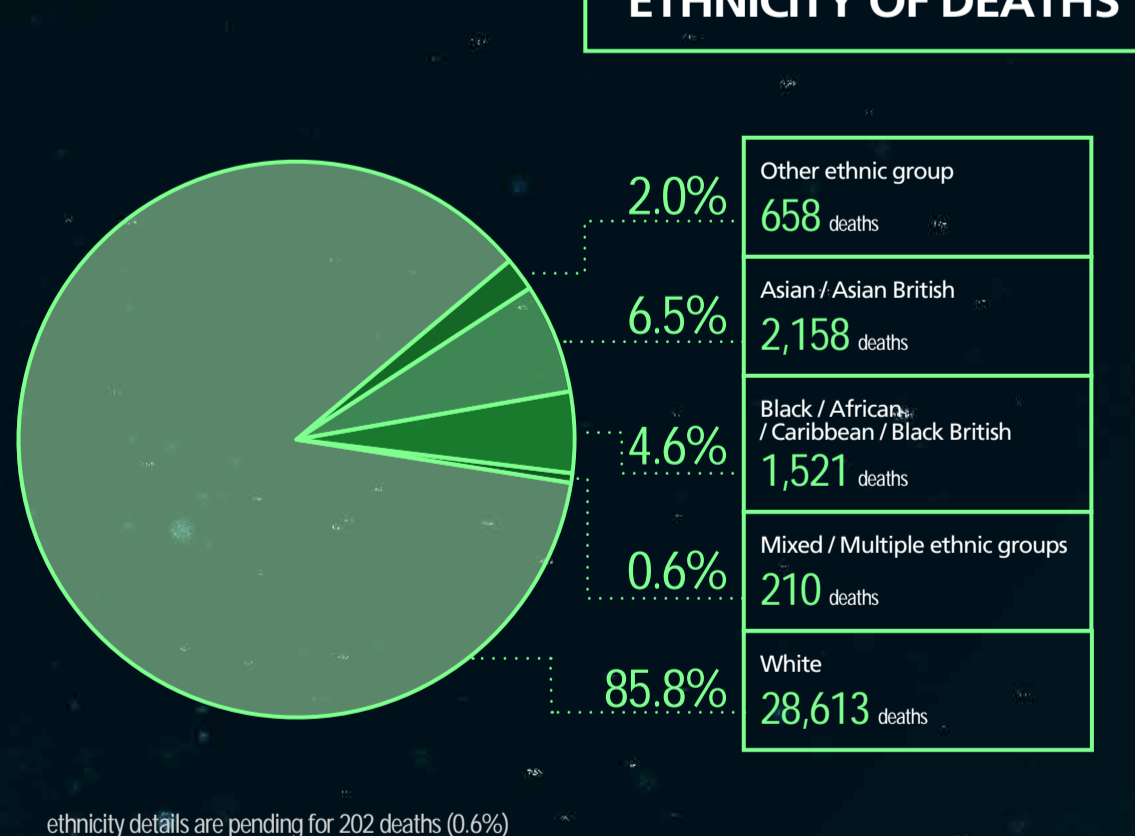
## EPIDEMIC CURVE
