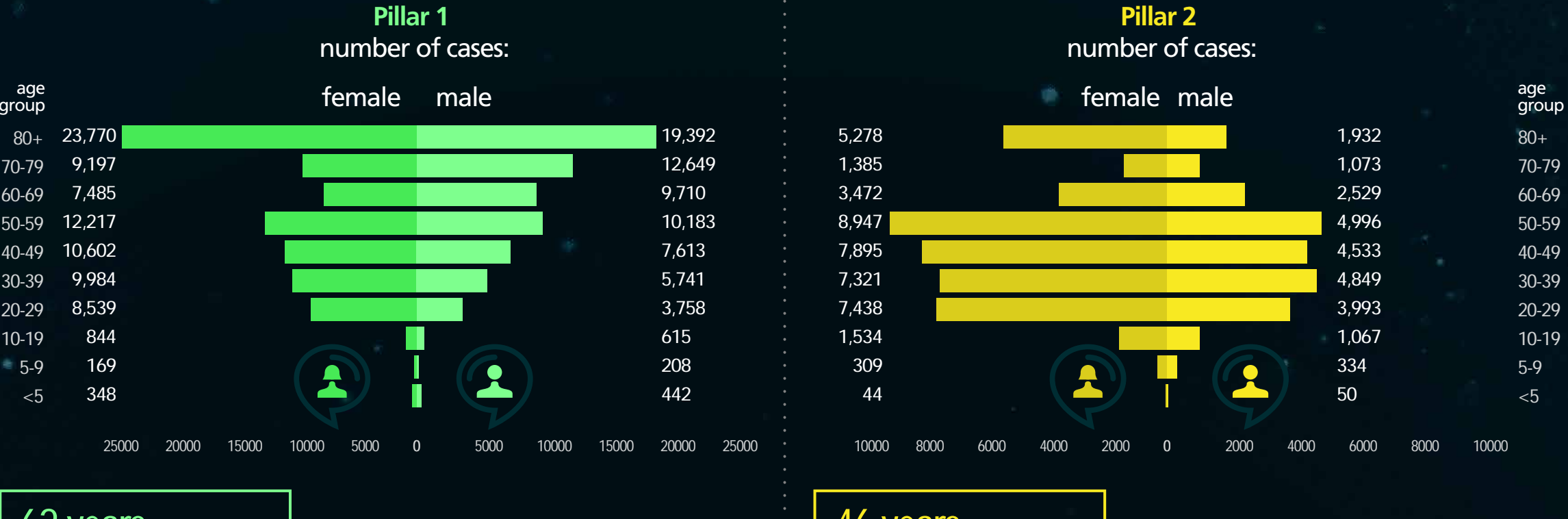

### POPULATION PYRAMID OF CASES

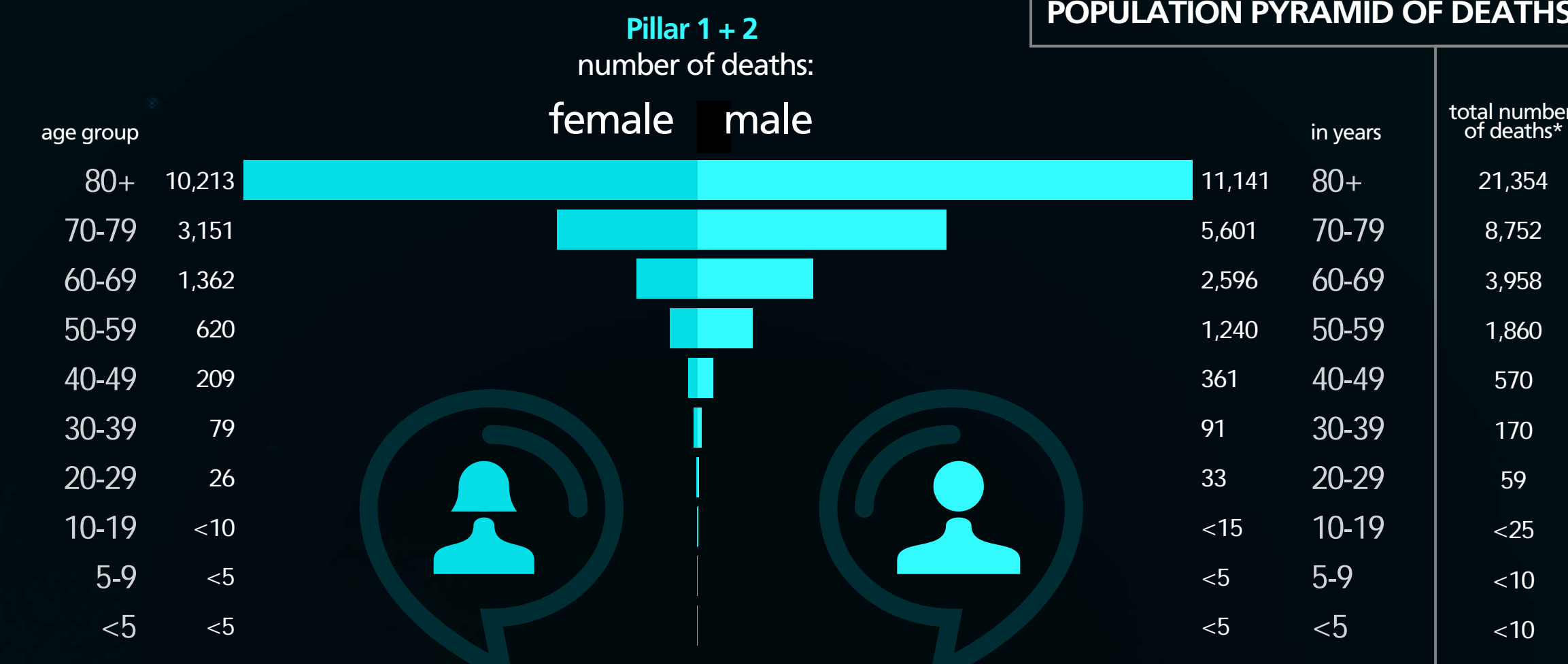

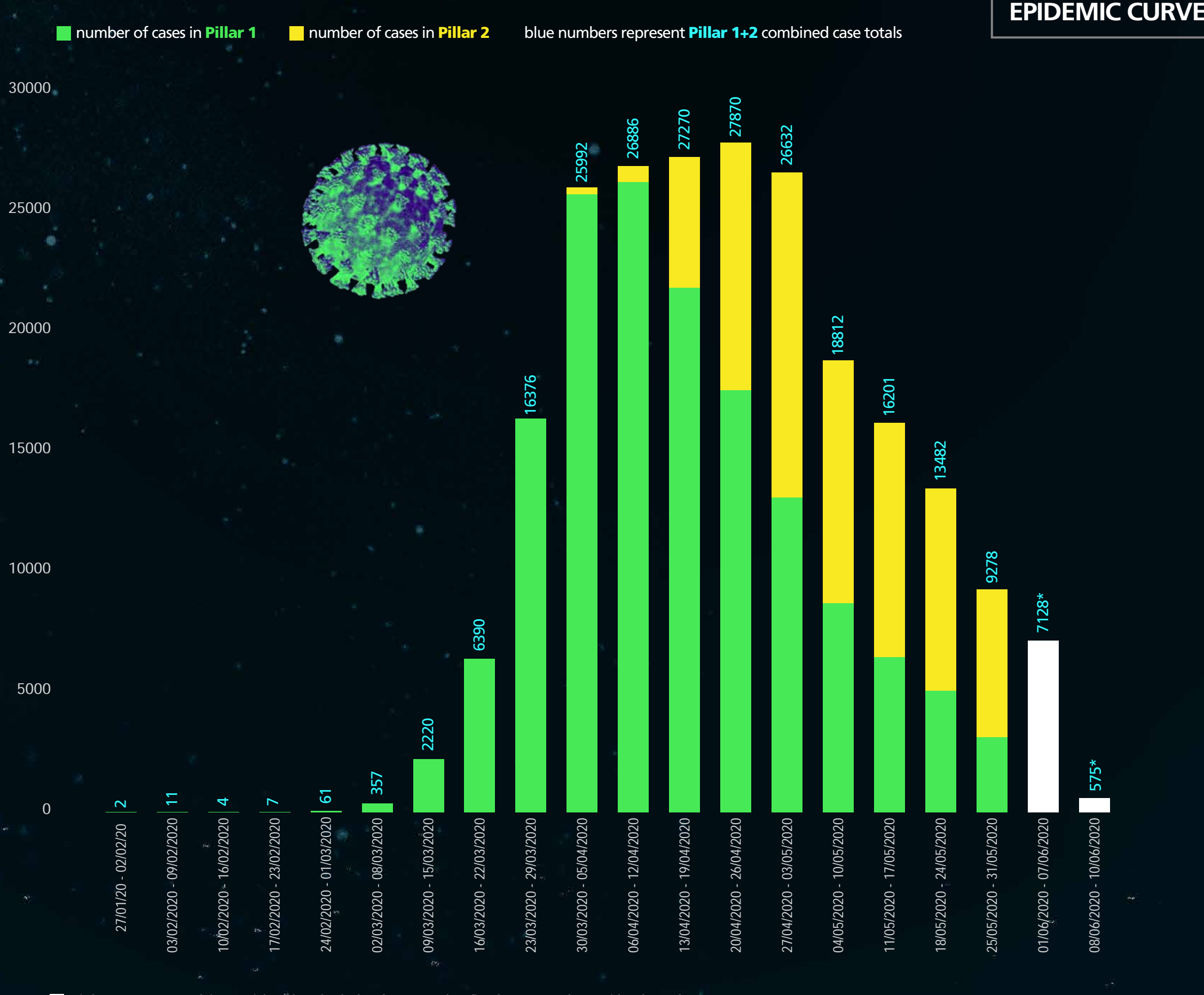

### POPULATION PYRAMID OF DEATHS



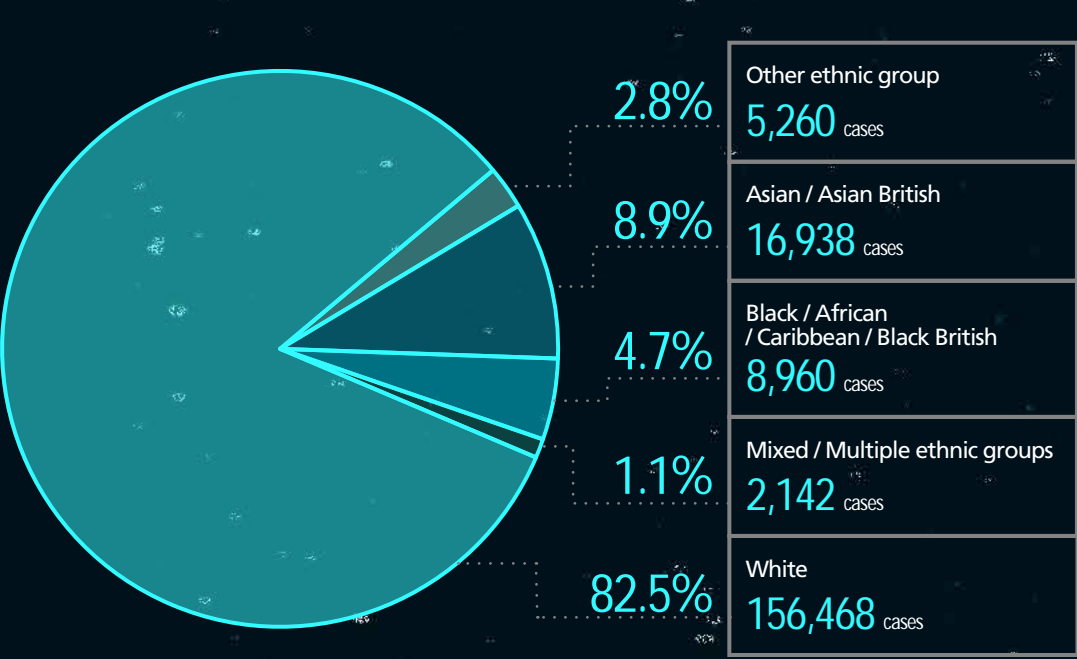

### EPIDEMIC CURVE



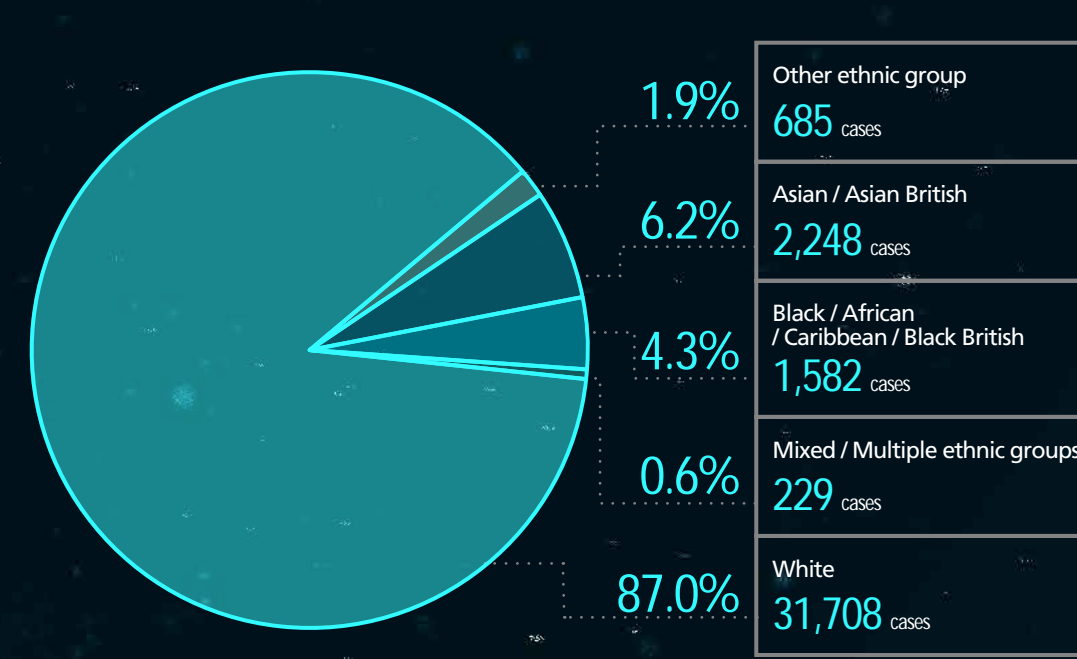
