List of Primary and Alternative Weather Sites

L4000 A Social Fund Cold Weather Payment (CWP) involves a payment of £25¹ for each cold weather period experienced by qualifying persons, in order to help provide for heating expenses. It is normally paid automatically by the relevant computer system.

Conditions of Entitlement

L4001 [See Memo ADM 03/21] A CWP will be made where

- **1.** a cold weather period (see **L4005**) is recorded or forecasted at an authorised Met Office (see **L4026**) site¹ (see **L4011**) and
- 2. the claimant's home²
 - **2.1** is situated in England or Wales (from 1.11.2022 Scotland cases will be dealt with by a devolved scheme)¹⁸
 - **2.2** is situated in a PO postcode district covered by the specified or specified alternative weather site **or**

- **2.3** is treated as situated in a PO postcode district covered by the nearest weather site where no alternative site is specified (see **L4012** et seq) and
- **3.** the claimant has been awarded for at least one day during the recorded or forecasted cold weather period
 - **3.1** SPC³
 - **3.2** IS⁴
 - **3.3** JSA(IB)⁵
 - **3.4** ESA(IR)⁶
 - 3.5 owner-occupier loan payments⁷ and is treated as entitled to a benefit specified in 3.1 3.4, or
 - **3.6** UC⁸and
- 4. For 3.2 to 3.6 either
 - **4.1** the family includes a child under age five ⁹ or
 - **4.2** the IS or JSA(IB) applicable amount includes one of the following premiums PP, EPP, HPP, DP, SDP, DCP, EDP¹⁰or
 - **4.3** they receive CTC which includes a disability element ¹¹or
 - **4.4** the ESA(IR) applicable amount includes one of the following premiums PP, SDP or EDP^{12} or
 - **4.5** they receive ESA(IR) and the claimant is a member of the work-related activity group (see **L4027**) or member of the support group (see **L4026**)or
 - 4.6 they receive owner-occupier loan payments and
 - **4.6a** the IS or JSA(IB) applicable amount would include one or more of the following premiums PP, EPP, HPP, DP, SDP, EDP **or**
 - **4.6b** the ESA(IR) applicable amount would include one or more of the following premiums PP. SDP or EDP.¹³
 - **4.7** the award of UC includes an amount for a child or qualifying young person who is disabled **or**
 - **4.8** the UC claimant has LCW or LCWRA¹⁴.

Note: In relation to 4.8 where the claimant would qualify for the carer element and the LCWRA element,

only one of those elements may be included in the award. The element to be included is the LCWRA if the claimant qualifies for it, or if not, the carer element.

- **5.** For UC claimants there is a further condition unless the award includes an amount for a child or qualifying young person who is disabled then a CWP is not payable if the claimant was in employment (see **L4024**) or gainful self-employment (see **L4025**) on
 - **5.1** any day during a recorded period of cold weather
 - **5.2** the day of the forecast in relation to a forecasted period of cold weather. ¹⁵
- **6.** There shall not be a CWP if the person resides in a care home (see **L4023**), independent hospital (see **L3161**), Abbeyfield Home or the Ilford Park Polish Home, except in the circumstances where **4.1** or **4.3** applies ¹⁶.

Note: If the claimant has been awarded Universal Credit and the person is in Ilford Park Polish home then CWP is still payable.¹⁷

Making a claim

L4002 If a CWP has not been paid automatically or clerically by the relevant computer systems, the DM should treat any representations about entitlement as a claim and decide whether there is any entitlement¹. The claimant has a right of appeal against the DM's decision to the First-tier Tribunal².

Time limits for claim

L4003 A CWP cannot be made more than 26 weeks from and including the last day of the 'winter period' (see **L4004**)in which the relevant period of cold weather falls¹. This allows time for a claimant to report a change if they feel they may have qualified after receiving their winter fuel bills in association with the winter season for which help with heating expenses is provided.

Winter Period

L4004 Winter period is defined as 1st November to 31st March of the following year.¹

Example

The claimant has been in receipt of IS since September 2010. In April 2020 he applies for a backdated payment of a CWP stating his child was born on 2.1.20 (but he did not notify the Department of the birth at the time). A cold weather period is recorded at the authorised Met office site for the claimant's postcode for the period 10.1.20 to 16.1.20. The DM decides he is entitled to a CWP as the claimant meets the entitlement criteria -there was a cold weather period recorded for the claimant's postcode, he was entitled to IS and had a child in his family younger than 5 - and the claim was made within the time limits.

Cold Weather Period

L4005 A cold weather period is a period of seven consecutive days during which the average mean daily temperature is recorded as, or is forecast to be, zero degrees celsius or below¹, by the designated Met Office site (see **L4011**).

L4006 Any day included in one cold weather period cannot be included in any other cold weather period.

Overlaps of recorded and forecast periods of cold weather


L4007 When a forecast period shares one or more days with a recorded period, the shared days will form an overlap period¹.

L4008 If both a recorded and forecast period of cold weather are linked by an overlap period, the DM should only make payment for the forecast period¹.

Example




Eligible period is days 1-13 inclusive. A CWP is made for the period 7-13.

L4009 Payment may be made for the last recorded period of cold weather 1 if

- 1. there is a continuous period of recorded and forecast periods and
- 2. each of those periods is linked by an overlap period and
- **3.** the total number of recorded periods exceeds the total number of forecast periods.

Example




- 1. Eligible period 15 days 1-14 inclusive
- **2.** A CWP is made for the forecast period 5-11
- **3.** A CWP is made for the last recorded period 8-14.
- **L4010** A payment can be made for the recorded period where the claimant
 - 1. would have been entitled to a CWP but for the fact that a forecast period takes priority and
 - **2.** is unable to satisfy the qualifying conditions for at least one day of the forecast period 1 .

Qualifying Conditions



- 1. Qualifying conditions satisfied in the recorded period up to day 4
- 2. Qualifying conditions not satisfied in the forecast period

- **3.** Eligible period is days 1-12
- **4.** A CWP is made for the period 1-7

The designated Met Office site

L4011 PO postcode districts¹ are linked to authorized weather sites. PO postcodes have four parts to them

- 1. area example LS14 1NX
- 2. district example LS14 1NX
- 3. sector example LS14 1NX
- 4. group of houses/building example LS14 1NX.

A postcode district may also include a letter at the end example SW1A.

The DM should ignore the letter at the end of the postcode district when deciding which weather site covers the claimant's home.

Note: When a forecast or recorded period of cold weather occurs the Met Office notify SF Problem Management, Live Support, who then notify DOs.

Note: From 9.7.20 all designated Met Office recording 'stations' are now referred to as 'sites'. ¹

Primary, Secondary and Alternative Sites

L4012 Primary site¹ means a site designated by the Secretary of State as a primary site for a postcode district².

Note: A list of the primary sites can be found at the end of this <u>chapter</u>.

L4013 Secondary site¹ means a site designated by the Secretary of State as a secondary site for a postcode district². A secondary site would be used in circumstances where

- 1. a primary site was unable to provide temperature information in respect of a particular day or
- 2. the Met Office is unable to produce a forecast in respect of a particular period at a primary site.

L4014 Alternative site¹ means a site which

- **1.** in the opinion of the Met Office, is the most geographically and climatologically representative for the postcode district in which the home of the claimant is situated and
- **2.** is able to provide the temperature information for the relevant

recorded or forecasted period of cold weather.

Note: An alternative site would be used to determine whether there is a recorded or forecasted period of cold weather in circumstances where

- 1. the primary and secondary site is unable produce the requisite information or
- **2.** the primary site is unable to produce the requisite information and there is no secondary site specified.

L4015 Where a primary site is unable to provide temperature information in respect of a particular day, the mean daily temperature of that day at

- 1. the secondary site or
- 2. an alternative site, where
 - **2.1** there is no secondary site designated **or**
 - **2.2** the secondary site is unable to provide temperature information in respect of that day

is to be used to determine whether or not there is a **recorded** period of cold weather at a primary site¹.

L4016 Where the Met Office is unable to produce a forecast in respect of a particular day at a primary site, the forecast in respect of that period produced at

- 1. the secondary site or
- 2. the alternative site, where
 - **2.1** there is no secondary site designated **or**
 - **2.2** the secondary site is unable to produce a forecast in respect of that period

is to be used to determine whether or not there is a forecasted period of cold weather at the primary

site¹.

L4017 Where the home of the claimant is not situated within a postcode district for which a primary site is designated, the home is to be treated as if it were situated within a postcode district

- **1.** which, in the opinion of the Met Office, is the most geographically and climatologically representative of that postcode district **and**
- **2.** for which a primary site is designated¹.

Publication and Review of Sites

L4018 A primary site **must** be designated for each postcode district. A secondary site **may** be designated for each postcode district¹.

L4019 Details of designated primary (and where appropriate, secondary) sites must be published. They are found at the end of this <u>chapter</u>. A CWP Postcode Tool is available at https://coldweatherpayments.dwp.gov.uk/

L4020 Each designation must be reviewed every 12 months, in the period beginning 1^{st} November and ending 31^{st} October¹.

L4021 If, on review or at any other time, a designation is no longer appropriate, the Secretary of State must

- 1. vary the designation expediently and
- **2.** publish details of the varied designation¹, in an appropriate manner².

Note: When determining whether to vary a designation, regard must be given to any recommendation made by the Met Office³.

L4022 For the purposes of a review or a variation¹, whether a designation is appropriate includes in particular, whether the site designated

- 1. is geographically and climatologically representative for the relevant postcode district and
- **2.** provides accurate temperature information.

Definitions

Care Home

L4023 Care home means¹ an establishment which provides accommodation, together with nursing or personal care for people who

- 1. are or have been ill
- 2. have or who have had a mental disorder
- 3. are disabled or infirm
- 4. are or have been dependent on alcohol or drugs

other than a hospital, independent clinic, children's home or other establishment excepted by regulations.

Employment

L4024 Means employment under a contract of service, or in an office, including an elective office.

Gainful Self-employment

L4025 A person is in gainful self employment where

- **1.**They are carrying on a trade, profession or vocation as their main employment;
- **2.** Their earnings from that trade, profession or vocation are treated as self-employed earnings for the purpose of regulations made under section 8(3) of the 2012 Act; and
- **3.** The trade, profession or vocation is organised, developed, regular and carried on in expectation of profit

Member of the support group

L4026 'Member of the support group' means¹ a claimant who has or is treated as having LCWRA and their assessment phase has ended.

Member of the work-related activity group

L4027 'Member of the work-related activity group' means¹ a claimant who has LCW or is treated as having LCW and their assessment phase has ended.

L4028 Met Office¹ means the Met Office of the Department for Business, Energy and Industrial Strategy.
