Applying for a British National Overseas (BNO) passport from Hong Kong

You must apply online: <https://www.gov.uk/overseas-passports>

How to apply

1. Get a digital passport photo

There are 3 ways:

- **Photo taken at home** You'll need someone to help you and a device that takes digital photos
- **Photo with a code** Get your photo taken in a booth or shop and get a code with your photo. Use the code to add the photo to your application
- **Photo in a digital file** Get your photo taken in a shop and get a digital file of your photo. Upload the file to add the photo to your application

2. Apply online

Fill in your personal details:

- Full name, date of birth and contact details
- BNO passport number

3. Pay for your new passport

You'll need a debit or credit card

4. Send us your documents

You must send original documents, unless we ask for a photocopy.

Your application will be delayed if you don't send everything we need.

You need to send:

- your most recent BNO passport (except if it is lost or stolen) - photocopies will not be accepted.
- a colour photocopy of both sides of your Hong Kong permanent identity card
- full colour photocopy of any passports from other countries that haven't expired (every page including blank pages)
- 1 of the following documents from the last 12 months that shows your name and address and/or residency:
 - letter from your employer
 - medical card
 - letter from your local council or a government department
 - voter's card
 - visa or residence permit (a colour photocopy will do)
 - education record for example a school report
 - Immigration documents
