



Summary of meeting - London Transition Board

9 June 2020, 1400-1500

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1. Chairs' welcome and introduction

- 1.1 The Board approved the terms of reference for the London Transition Board (LTB) and the London Transition Management Board (LTMB), subject to amendments to reflect comments from partners.

2. Situational Analysis: Overview of current position in London

- 2.1 The Board was updated on London SCG COVID-19 Situational Awareness, covering the impacts of lockdown changes on demand in key sectors and the risk analysis relating to different phases.
- 2.2 Data from London was shared, which focused on testing, mortality management and transport movements. A discussion followed including focus on the following:
- Key points from all London boroughs;
 - Compliance with lockdown rules and the policing challenges presented;
 - An update for the NHS, and on planning in relation to response and recovery; and
 - An update on TfL.

3. Strategic themes – to agree strategic themes for the board to focus on over near-term, and strategy group leads

- 3.1 The draft strategic themes and suggested leads were outlined. It was noted that group membership and leadership should be representative of London's diversity.
- 3.2 It was agreed that increased public confidence would be critical to recovery.

4. Deep dive – future infection and outbreak control, including test, trace, and contain and future work plan

- 4.1 The Board were presented an overview of testing and contact tracing in London highlighting five key priorities for London:
- Effective viral suppression, through reinforcing messages about hygiene, facemasks, social distancing, testing and contact tracing
 - Restarting public health and care services
 - Prioritising public health outcomes
 - Tackling health inequalities
 - Preparing for any second wave

- 4.2 The Board were advised that London was represented at national level, including on a national best practice network. A discussion followed including focus on the following:
- An overview of test, track and trace was provided and highlighted that local leadership and united action were key to success.
 - The Board noted that future data sharing plans and said that data for upper tier authority level would be available shortly.
