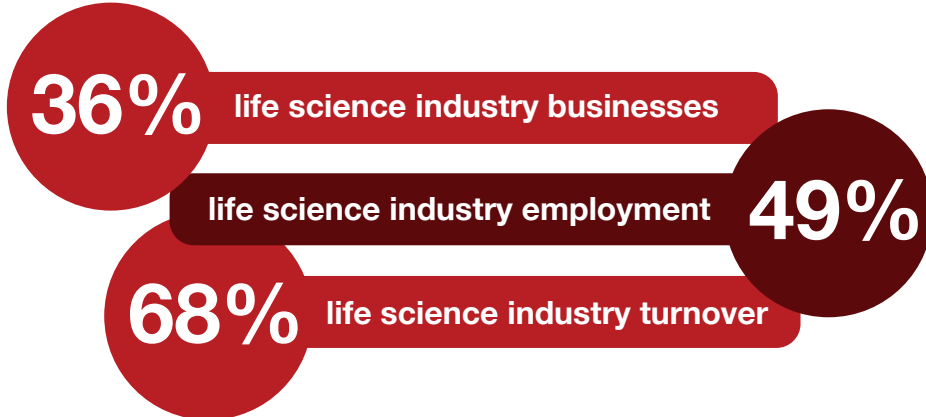

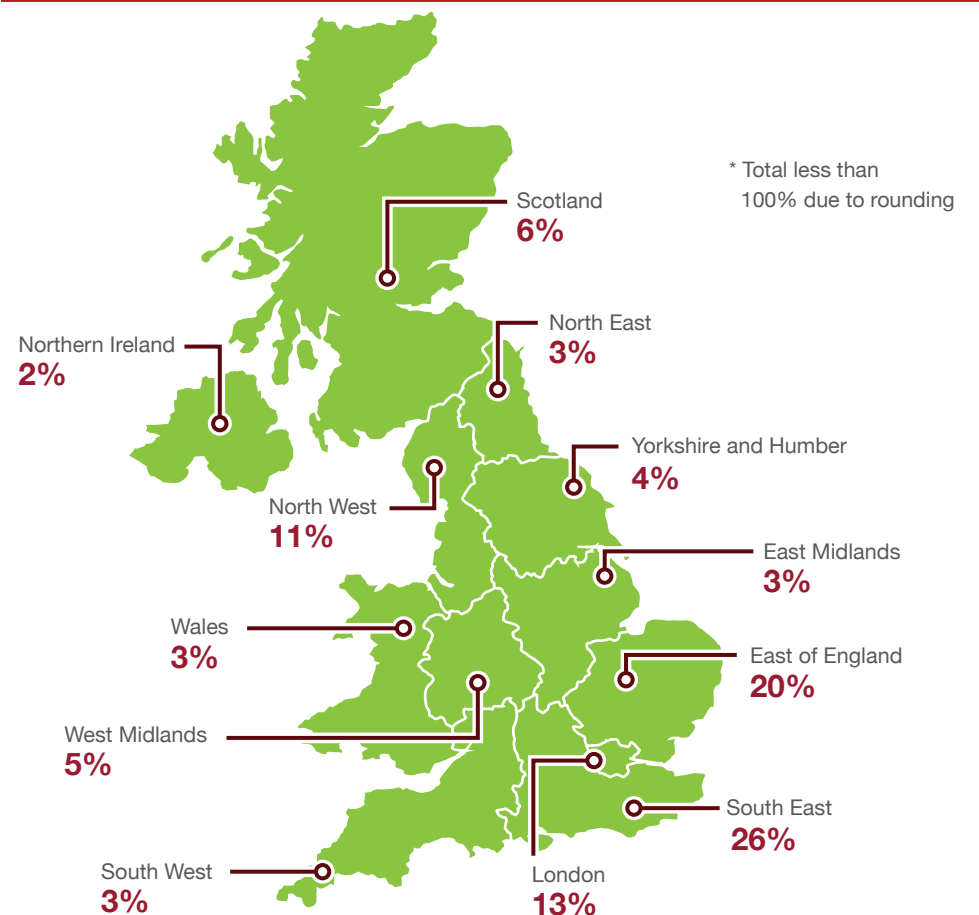


What is the Biopharmaceutical Sector?

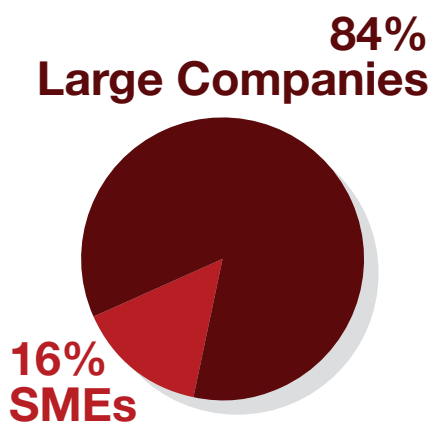

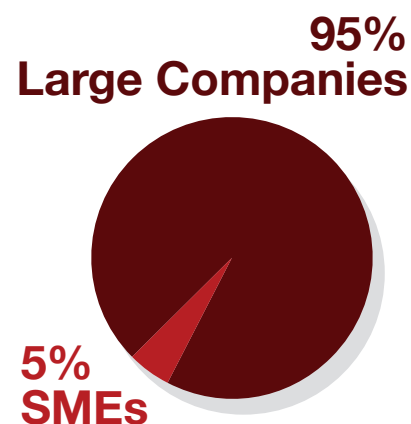
Distribution of Employment Across UK



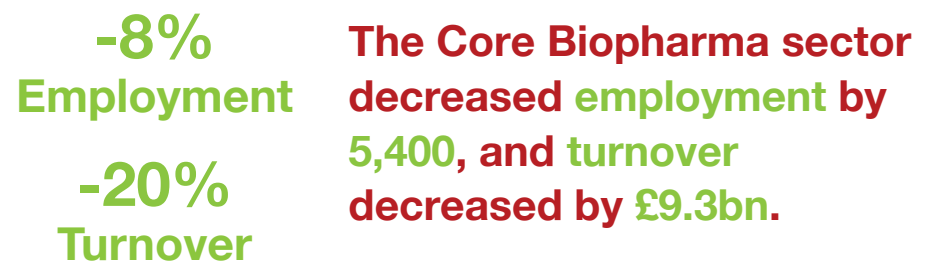
Sector Employment



Sector Turnover



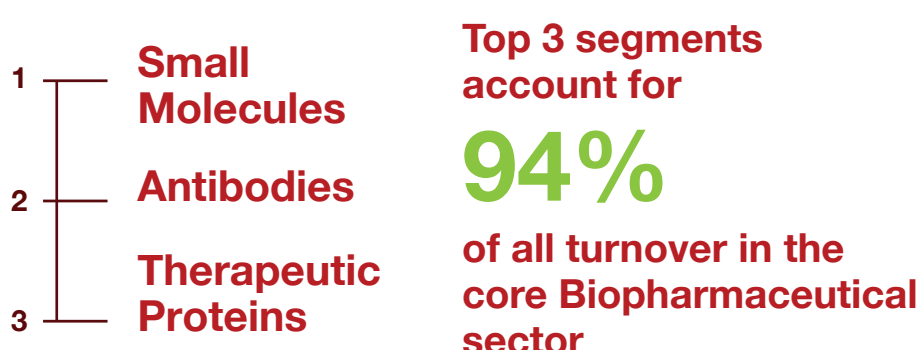
Year-On-Year Growth - 2010 to 2019
