Grant Determination Letter for Devolution of the Adult Education Budget: Notification of Adult Education Budget Allocation for Academic year 2019/20, which spans Financial Years 2019-2020 and 2020-2021 (DfE reference number GR1000749)

This Determination is made between:

- (1) The Secretary of State for Education and
- (2) The Mayor of London

I am pleased to be writing to you to confirm the Adult Education Budget (AEB) grant for the period 1 August 2019 to 31 July 2020, following devolution of adult education functions and the associated AEB to the Greater London Authority (GLA) from 1 August 2019.

The Secretary of State has delegated certain adult education functions to you under section 39A of the Greater London Authority Act 1999. This delegation of functions, and the transfer of those functions to certain Mayoral Combined Authorities (MCAs) are both referred to in this letter as the devolution of adult education functions.

Your budget allocation for 2019/20 following devolution of adult functions and the associated AEB from August 2019 will be transferred in accordance with Section 39A of the Greater London Authority Act 1999. The AEB will be provided to the GLA on your behalf.

# Amount and purpose of the grant

The Department will allocate £306,444,875 (£191,987,714 in FY 2019-20, £114,457,161 in FY 2010-21) to you for the provision of relevant adult education functions in relation to the Greater London area for the period 01 August 2019 to 31 July 2020.
