Reason for change (including benefits)

To capture policy requirements for the 2020 to 2021 academic year.

There is a risk that school exclusions will 'spike' when schools return in September.

From September it is possible pupils will be excluded for failing to follow COVID protective measures. It is unclear which exclusion reason code in the school census schools would select for an exclusion of this kind. Therefore, to support schools a COVID-specific reason code is proposed to capture this data.

We are aware that it may not be possible for all suppliers to include it by 1st September 2020 therefore we propose to specify in guidance for schools to use this code as appropriate as soon as it becomes available on their system.

This will enable us to have robust data on exclusions which fully reflects the reasons for exclusions.

Academic year 20/21 is also the first year that schools will be able to select up to 3 reasons for an exclusion so this temporary change will form part of wider amendments to recording.

Impact of not doing the change

Data quality would not be as great and would not enable the department to gain a national view and scale of exclusions in relation to coronavirus.

Software suppliers' summary of impact assessment

Software supplier impact received via correspondence prior to RFC being drafted:

The majority of suppliers would be able to implement for use at the start of the autumn term. Either making available for use from 2020-09-01 or included in their next release with the functionality for schools to back date where the reason was not available at the point of entering the exclusion on the MIS.

Brief Summary of Discussion

Following a review of comments and the need for this data to be collected it was agreed we should proceed.

As the exclusion collection period runs from 2020-08-01, suppliers would need to enable the backdating of exclusion reasons from this date for completeness.

Guidance would need to be updated to ensure schools are aware that where the reason is unavailable in systems, they should ensure it is updated when made available and certainly prior to the data being collected by the department.
