Reason for change (including benefits)

After review of legal basis, it has been agreed that the sharing of pupil data with local authorities and youth support services would come under legal obligation and s72 of the Education and Skills act 2008. The parent / guardian or pupil (aged16+) would need to exercise their right to object to any information other than name, address & DOB being shared.

Therefore, the codeset that reflects opt-in (as per GDPR) needs refreshing along with census guidance & suggested texts for privacy notices.
