Description of change:

To add new code to collect functional skills prior attainment

GCSE funding exemption

Code	Description
L	A learning disability prevents the pupil from studying for the qualification(s)
0	A recognised overseas equivalent qualification is held by the pupil
U	Learner has met the GCSE condition of funding as they hold an approved equivalent UK qualification
N	No exemption
F	Learner holds a pass grade for functional skills level 2

Reason for change (including benefits):

The change means that full time students with a grade 2 or below in maths or English can study towards a pass in functional skills level 2 (legacy or reformed) or they can still study towards a GCSE grade 9 to 4.

This also applies to part time students who have a grade 3 or grade D GCSE or equivalent. Once they have achieved this, there is no requirement to undertake further maths or English qualifications to meet the condition of funding.

Those with a grade 3 must still study an eligible GCSE qualification in order to meet the condition of funding.
