Appeals and Permission to Appeal applications to UTIAC:

- All appeals to UTIAC are being judicially case managed.
- Appeals are currently being heard via audio or video options, alongside restricted face to face hearings in line with social distancing measures.

- A notice was issued on 23 March 2020 on handling of urgent Judicial review applications.
- An updated notice was issued on 30 April 2020 on handling non-urgent applications.

- As of 7th September 2020, the Fees counter will be open between 10am and 12pm and 2pm-4:15pm Monday to Friday. Please note you may be required to queue outside the building to support social distancing measures.
