Under 10m North Sea Cod



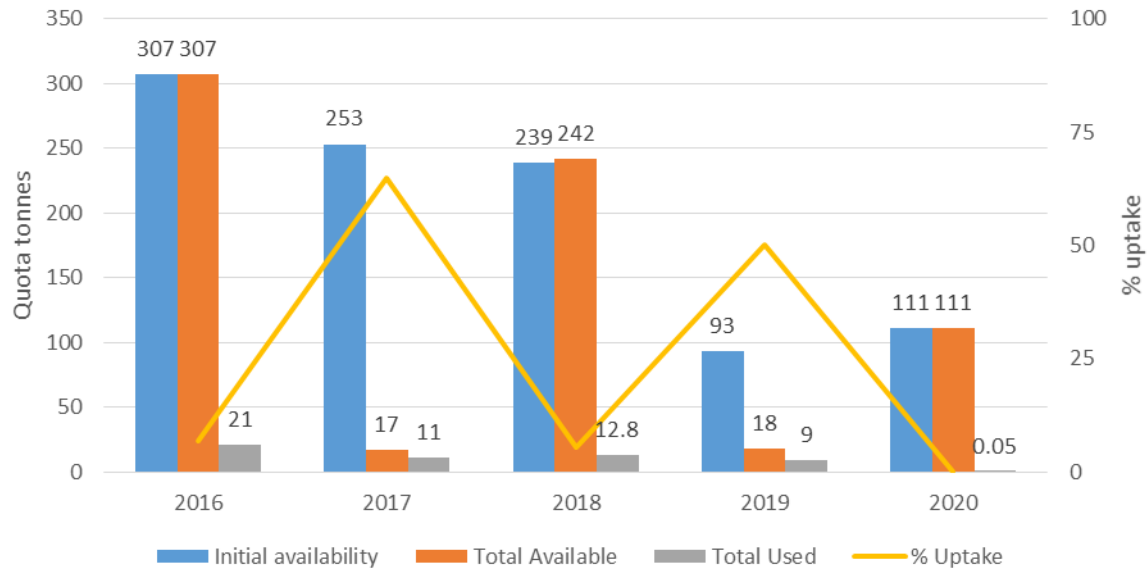
50% Cut and non-sector unlikely to get reserve quota allocation.

Catch limits reduced to 1t. 1x landing at 1.3t in Feb last year. All other landings <1t.

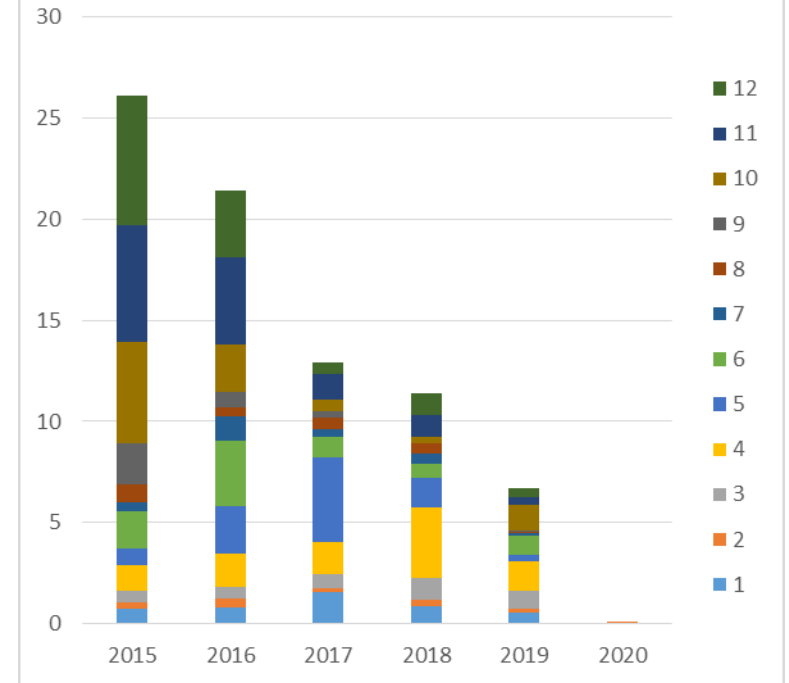
Over 10s landed 8t in 2019 and have 5t available in 2020.

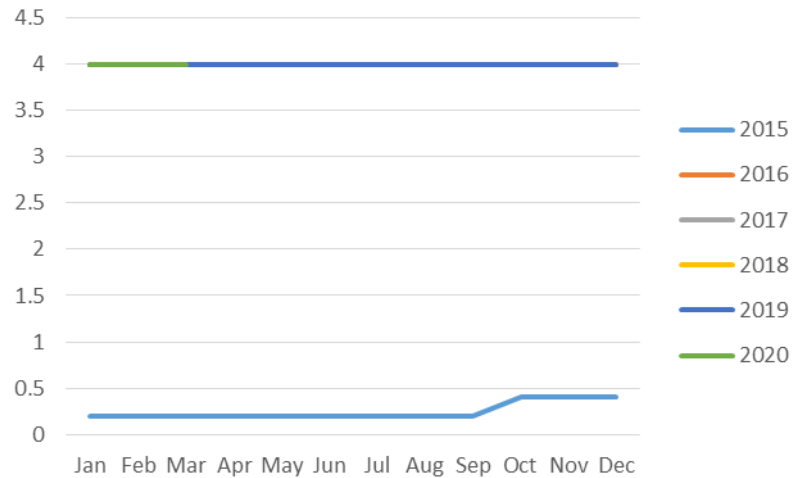
Available quota and total uptake

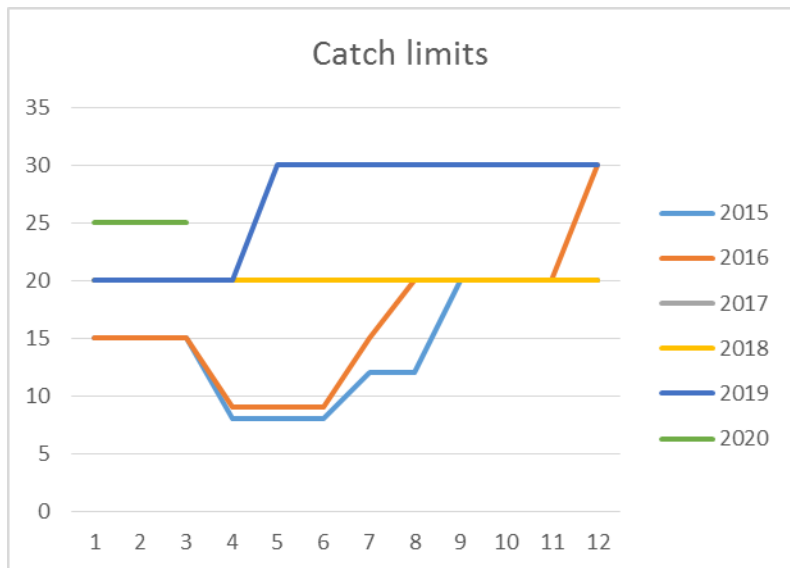
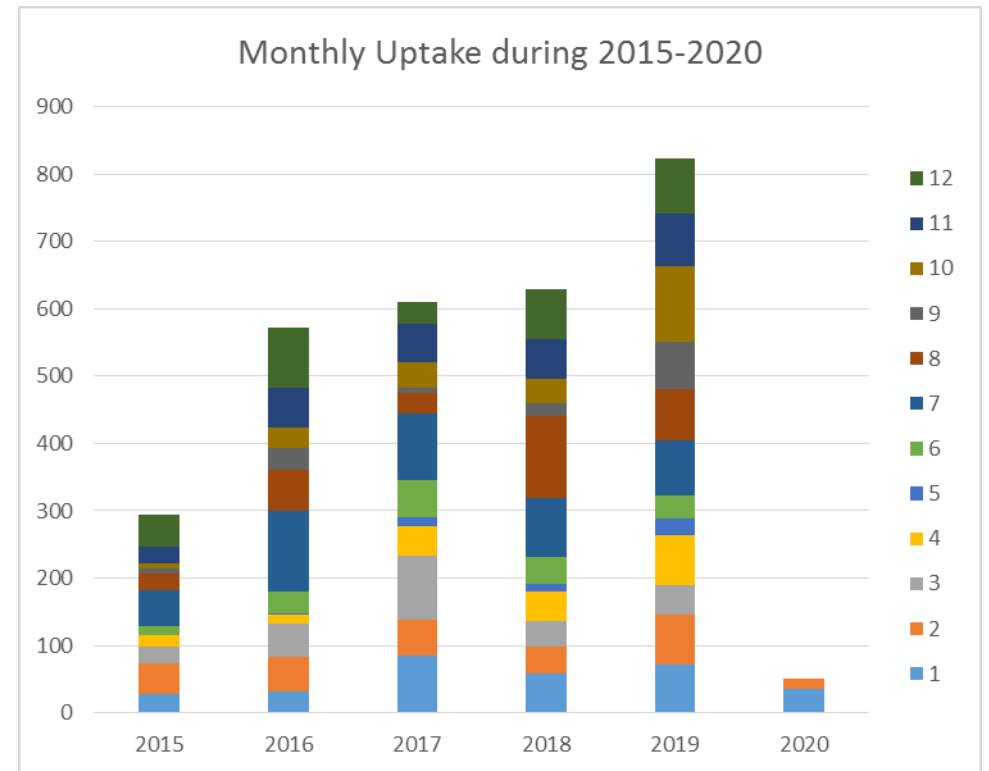
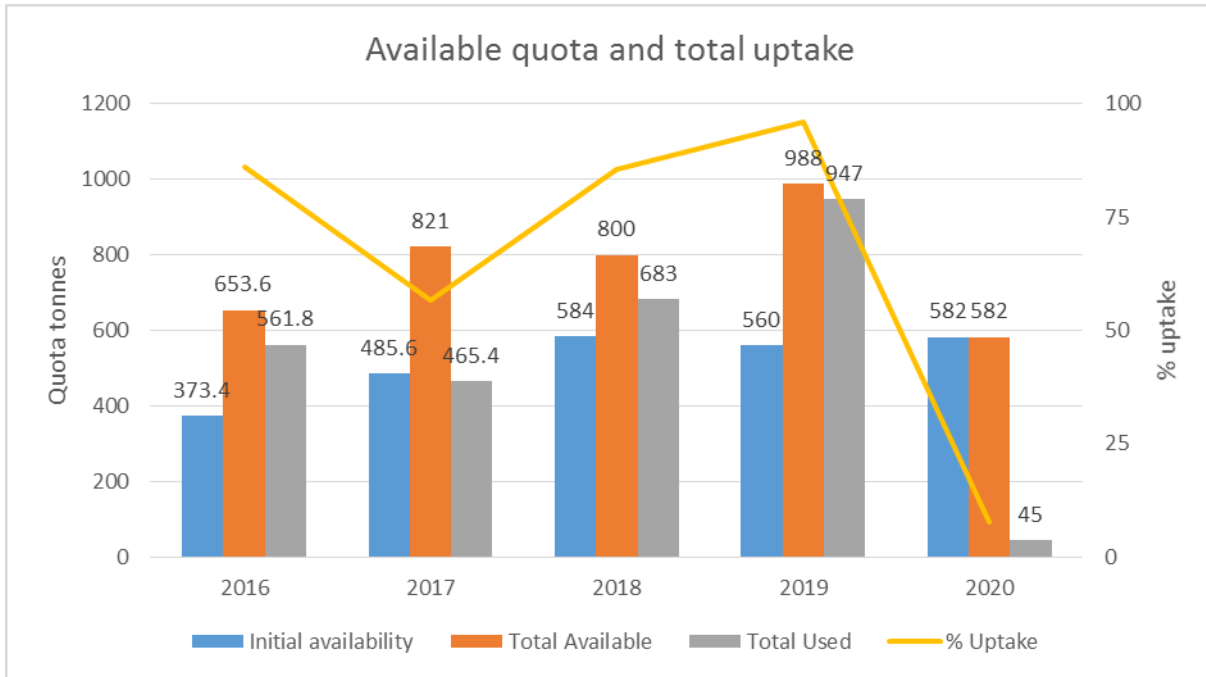


Highest landings are from Leigh-On-Sea and Eastbourne. Catch limits significantly higher than landings.

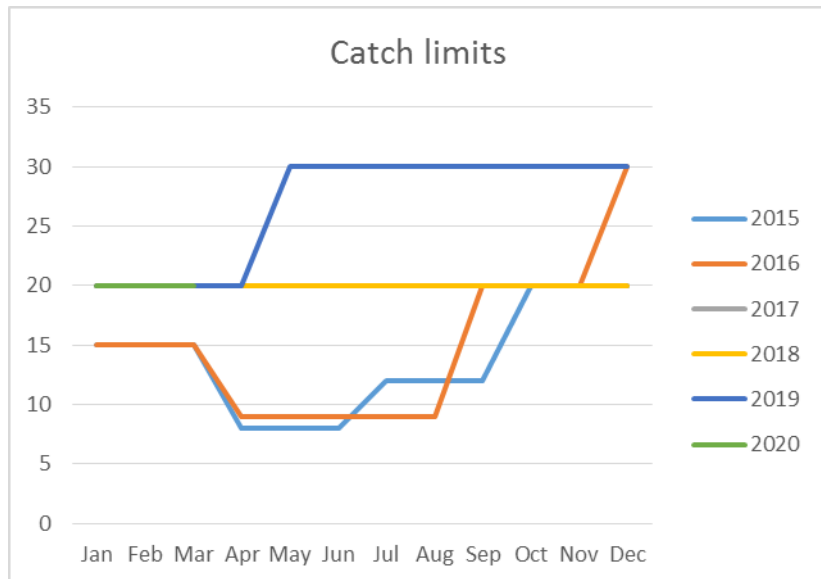
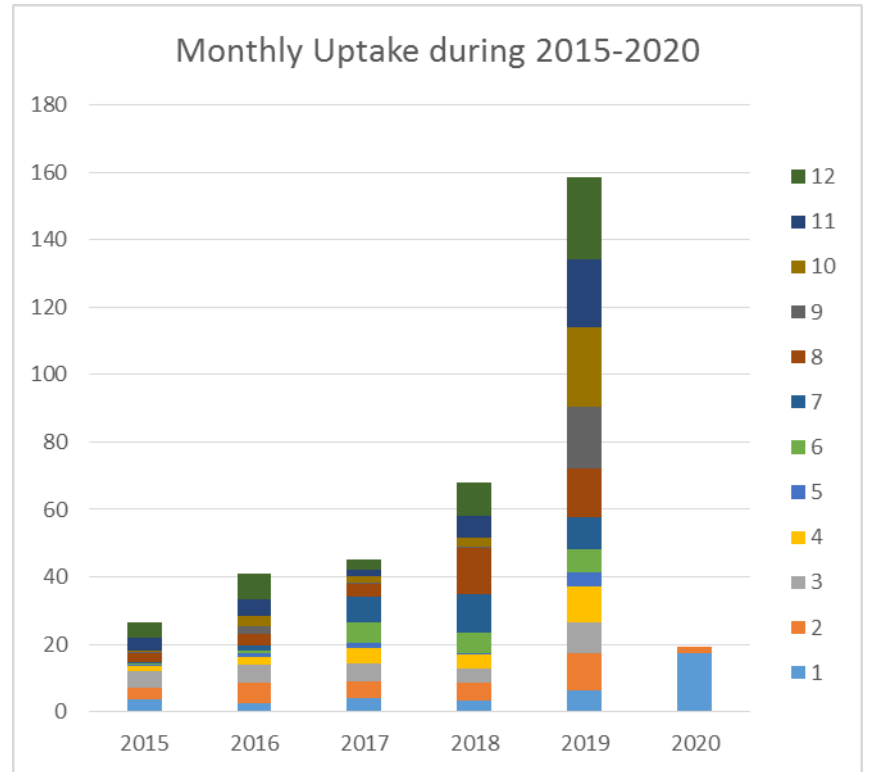
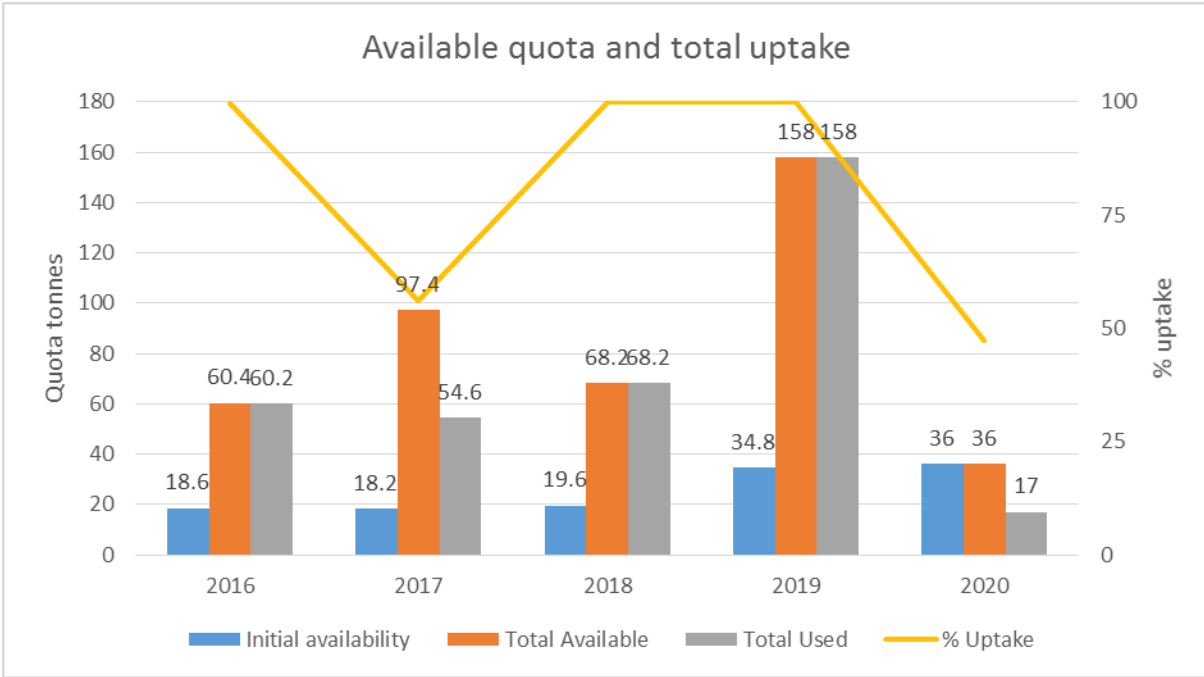
Predominantly a 4b fishery.

18t used for flex into 7d into 2019.

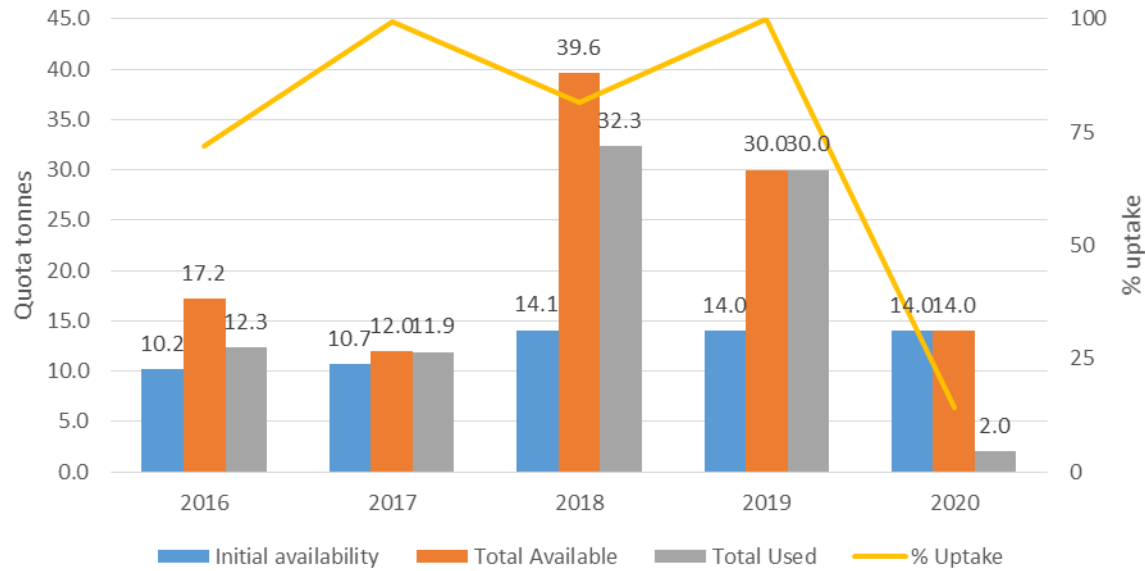

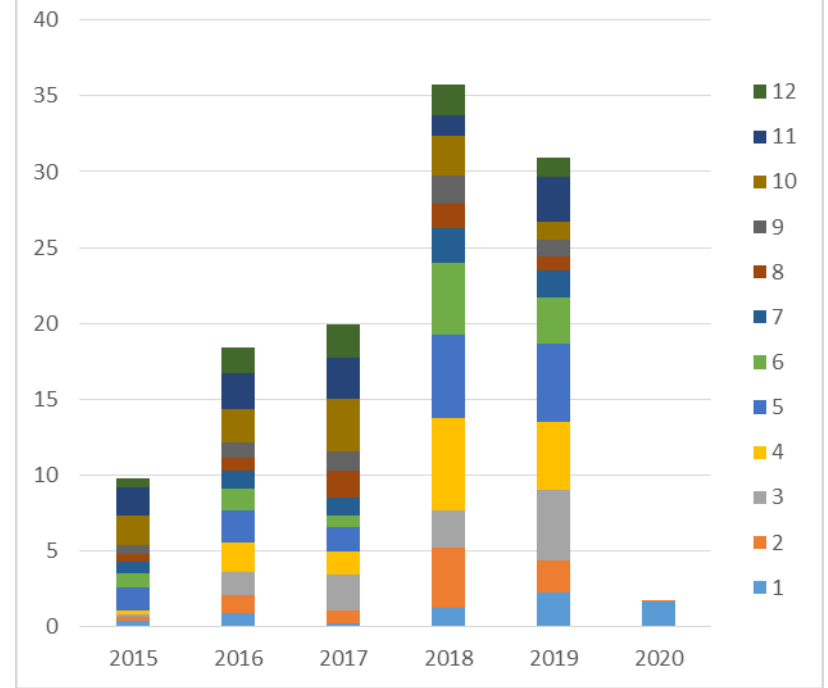

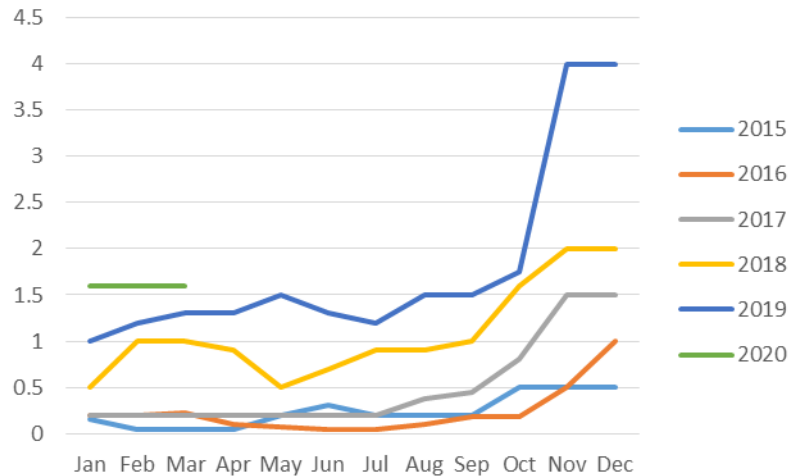
Available quota and total uptake

Quota runs July to June.

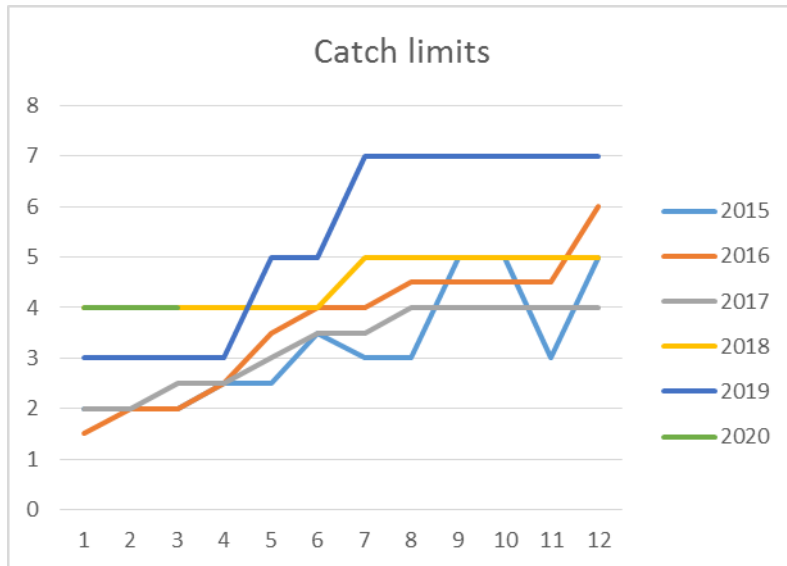
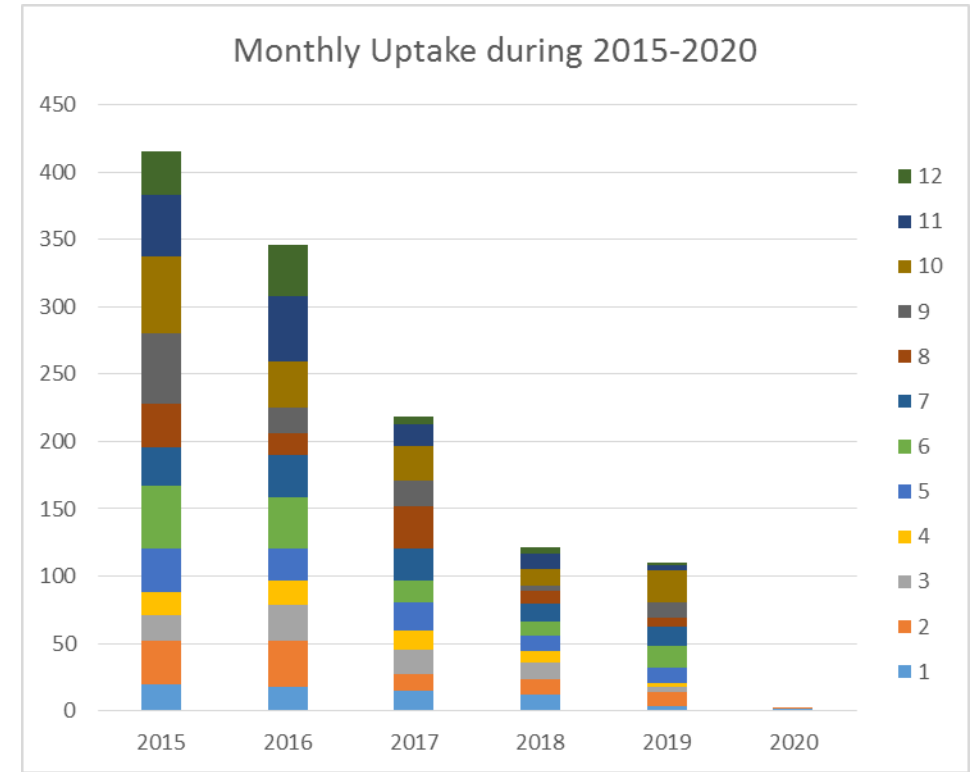
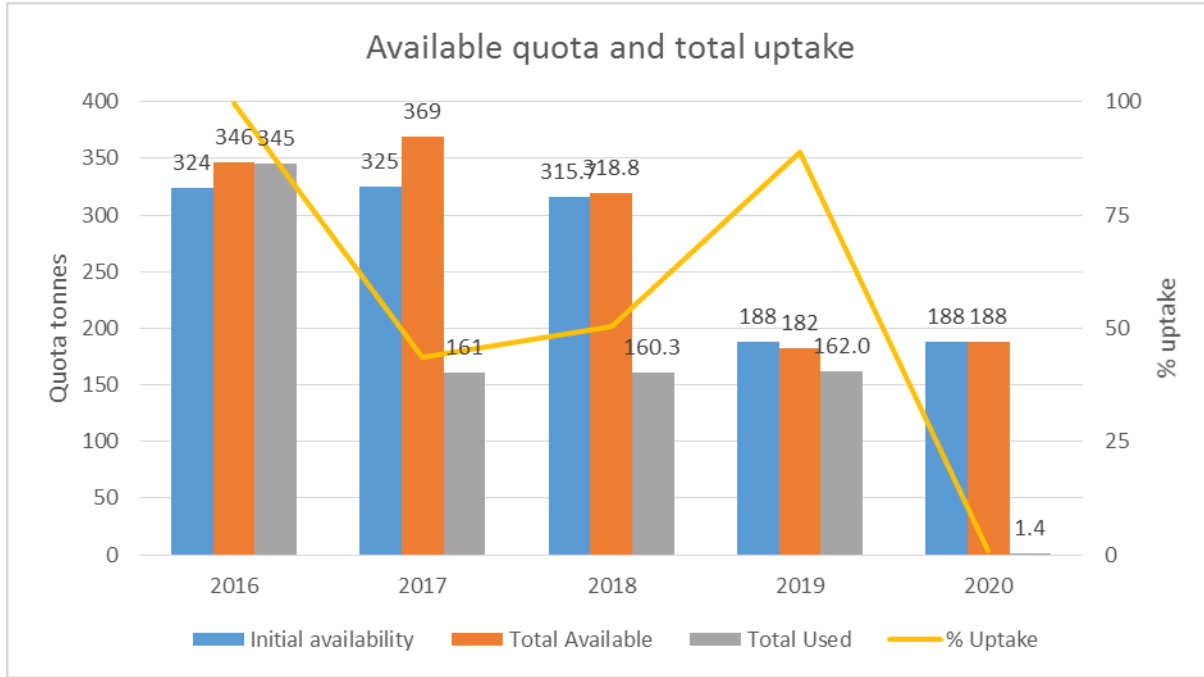
This is a weekly catch limit and could be too high at 10t?

Significant 4b Fishery and now more a winter fishery.

155t of reserve quota in 2019. - Fishery depends on this allocation in 2020.

Can be a useful trading quota UK uptake 90% in 2019 with >1000t remaining.

Suggest for caution reduce to 3t? Would this affect you?
