3. Can I please have a year by year breakdown breakdown of the number of people serving with the ranks of Major or its equivalent across the Army, Navy, Air Force and (if possible) Royal Marines? This would be for the years 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019? This includes reservists.

4. Can I please have a five year breakdown - to the number and not rounded up to the nearest 10 - of the number of BAME people serving with the ranks of Major or its equivalent across the Army, Navy, Air Force and (if possible) Royal Marines? This would be for the years 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019? This includes reservists."

We are treating your correspondence as a request for information under the Freedom of Information Act 2000 (FOIA).

We have now completed a search for the information you requested and I can confirm that some information in scope of your request is held.
