As at 25th September 2020, 138 decisions have been made on the basis that sufficient supporting information has now been received, 65 registered buildings are proceeding with a full application and 73 have been shown to be ineligible and withdrawn by registrants. The eligibility of buildings is assessed against if they have unsafe cladding, the height of the building and if leaseholders are present in the building.

The Department does not intend to publish a building by building list of decisions and their rationale. These are communicated to registrants who we expect will ensure that their residents are kept fully informed.
