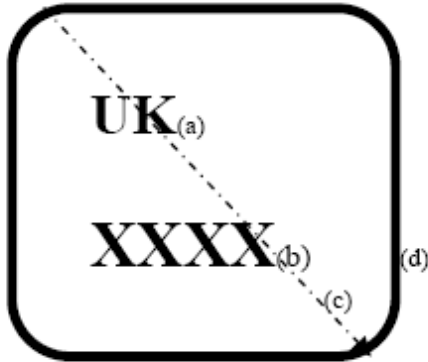

Schedule

The following mark is to be used for the purpose of Article 63(2)(a) of the Avian Influenza and Influenza of Avian Origin in Mammals (England) (No.2) Order 2006.



- (a) UK – letters 8 mm high;
- (b) XXXX (where XXXX is the approval number of the premises, as referred to in point 7 of Part B of Section I of Annex II to Regulation (EC) No 853/2004) – Numbers 11 mm high;
- (c) diameter (to outer edge of border) - not less than 30 mm;
- (d) thickness of border - 3 mm.

The mark must be legible to the naked eye.

When applied to retail packaging, the size of the mark may vary according to the size of the packaging; however, it must be legible to the naked eye.

Notes

This mark is the same as that described in Paragraph 2 of the Schedule of the Avian Influenza (H5N1 in Poultry) (England) Order 2006 No. 3247
