- 2) This revocation takes effect from 14.30 on 25 December, thereby ending the measures imposed in the 10 kilometre Surveillance Zone centred on grid reference SK7723021404 declared on 17 December 2020, which had replaced the original declaration of a Protection and Surveillance zone dated 23 November.
